Event Description

The IEEE SIES GST student branch conducted WriTech, a technical article writing competition, for students to indulge and explore about technical topics during this lockdown period of the CoVid-19 pandemic. The event was a huge success as we had close to 100 participants submitting well-read technical articles.

The competition was announced on social media handles of IEEE SIES GST such as LinkedIn and Instagram and was also spread as WhatsApp messages as well as word of mouth. Interested participants were asked to join a WhatsApp group for ease of communication and the guidelines for articles were given in the same group. The articles were submitted through a google form. The students who had submitted were moved into a different group.

The articles submitted were firstly stipulated on plagiarism percentage. The articles with more than 30% plagiarism were eliminated. Articles in the top 30% of each round were assessed by the consequent round's jury. All rounds judged the articles on the following criteria:

1. Accuracy
2. Innovation
3. Grammar
4. Vocabulary

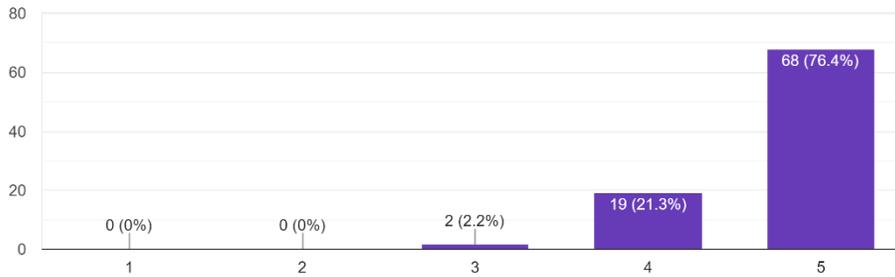

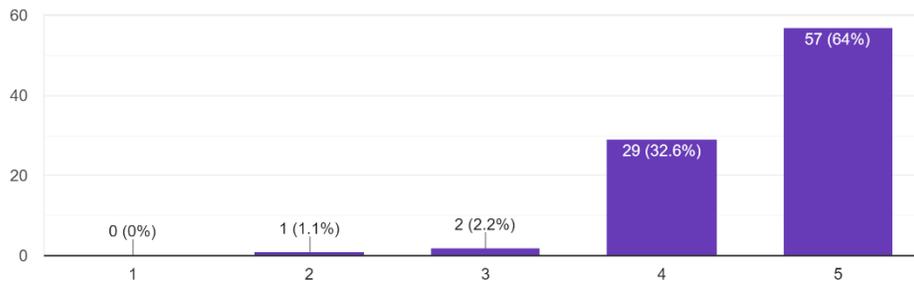
How clear were the provided guidelines?

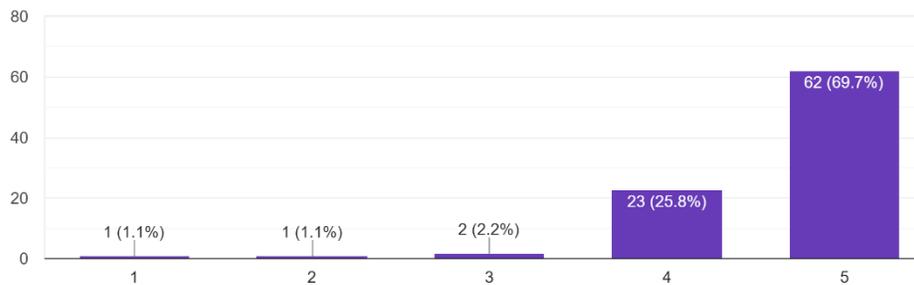
Were doubts aptly cleared?

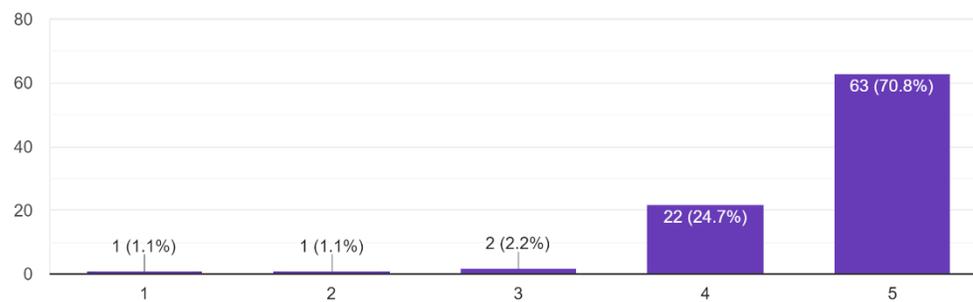
Was the article topic appreciable?
