Activity	Details
Tiranga Yatras	 Tiranga Yatras are a key part of the Har Ghar Tiranga movement. Young and old, men and women all may join the yatras across the length and breadth of India to celebrate and honour the National Flag, bringing a sense of national pride and unity.
Tiranga Rallies	■ Bike, cycle, and car rallies dedicated to the spirit Tiranga are organized as part of Har Ghar Tiranga with active participation of hobby groups, youth volunteers, representatives of States.
Tiranga Runs and Marathons	 Runs and marathons dedicated to the spirit of Tiranga celebrating the values of the national flag to be scheduled in the run up to Independence Day. People from all walks of life are encouraged to join and honour the flag that binds us all together.

Activity	Details
Tiranga Concerts	 Large public concerts will be organized with patriotic music. The Tiranga Anthem from the Ministry of Culture will be played at all concerts. These events aim to create a festive atmosphere and celebrate our national pride through music. Tiranga Anthem will be available for download in the download section of Har Ghar Tiranga website.
Tiranga Canvas	 Tiranga Canvases will be set up at event venues where people can write 'Har Ghar Tiranga' or 'Jai Hind' in any Indian language. Each canvas is designed in the same ratio as the national flag (3:2). Reference design template for the Tiranga Canvas available for download on Har Ghar Tiranga website.
Tiranga Pledge	 The Tiranga Pledge will be part of all programs, encouraging people to commit to the values of the flag. Community cleaning and pledge-taking activities will be organized near Shilaphalakams from earlier campaigns, reinforcing the spirit of the Tiranga. Approved copy of Tiranga pledge will be available for download in the download section of Har Ghar Tiranga website.

Tiranga Selfies	 Participants are encouraged to hoist the flag and take selfies with the Tiranga and upload them to the Har Ghar Tiranga website (harghartiranga.com). Certificates can be shared on social media with #HarGharTiranga and #HGT2024. 	
Tiranga Tribute	 Bravehearts and freedom fighters, along with their families, to be remembered, honored and felicitated in local programs on behalf of a grateful nation. 	
Tiranga Melas	 Tiranga Melas will support local artisans and add to the festive mood. Stalls selling flags, merchandise, and food will be set up around event venues, creating a lively and celebratory atmosphere.

Lighting Up of Railways Stations






Ministry of Civil Aviation

Ministry of Information and Broadcasting 1/3




- Logo Flips and Tiranga Tickers on TV Channels

 - Hindi film industry, artists who work in Hindi TV serials / music industry
 - South film industry, artists who work in Tamil/ Telegu, Malayalam, Kannada TV serials / music industry
 - Bangla film industry, artists who work in Bangla TV serials / music industry
 - Marathi/ Gujarati film industry, artists who work in Marathi/ Gujarati TV serials / theatre / music industry
 - Punjabi film industry, artists who work in Punjabi TV serials / music industry

Ministry of Information and Broadcasting 3/3



- Tie up with local PIB, radio channels for live coverage of Yatras, Runs and Rallies
 - State nodal for Har Ghar Tiranga available with Ministry of Culture
 - Local PIB units may contact state nodals for further amplification, ensure schedules also reach private media.
 - Maximum participation of media for launch and finale events, State events etc.
- SMS and push messages campaign in collaboration with MeitY, D/o Telecommunications



Ministry of Textiles



- Encourage flag vendors to participate in Har Ghar Tiranga movement
- Outreach amongst weaver and artisan communities.
- Handicraft: Tiranga merchandise for Tiranga melas
- Special programmes and installations: across all locations of National Institute of Fashion Technology
- Integrate Tiranga in existing exhibitions and programmes being undertaken by the Ministry.
 - Example : Know Your Weaves,
 Plantation activities etc.

 - Click a picture and post on social media.
 - If possible, <u>record an appeal for participation in HGT</u> from the person on phone.
 - Request the person to amplify HGT from his / her social channels/ pages.

- Display of Tiranga Exhibition at post Offices
- Selfie points at all post offices




Ministry of Communications (Department of Post)
