- No feedback mechanism to improve the quality of the annual events

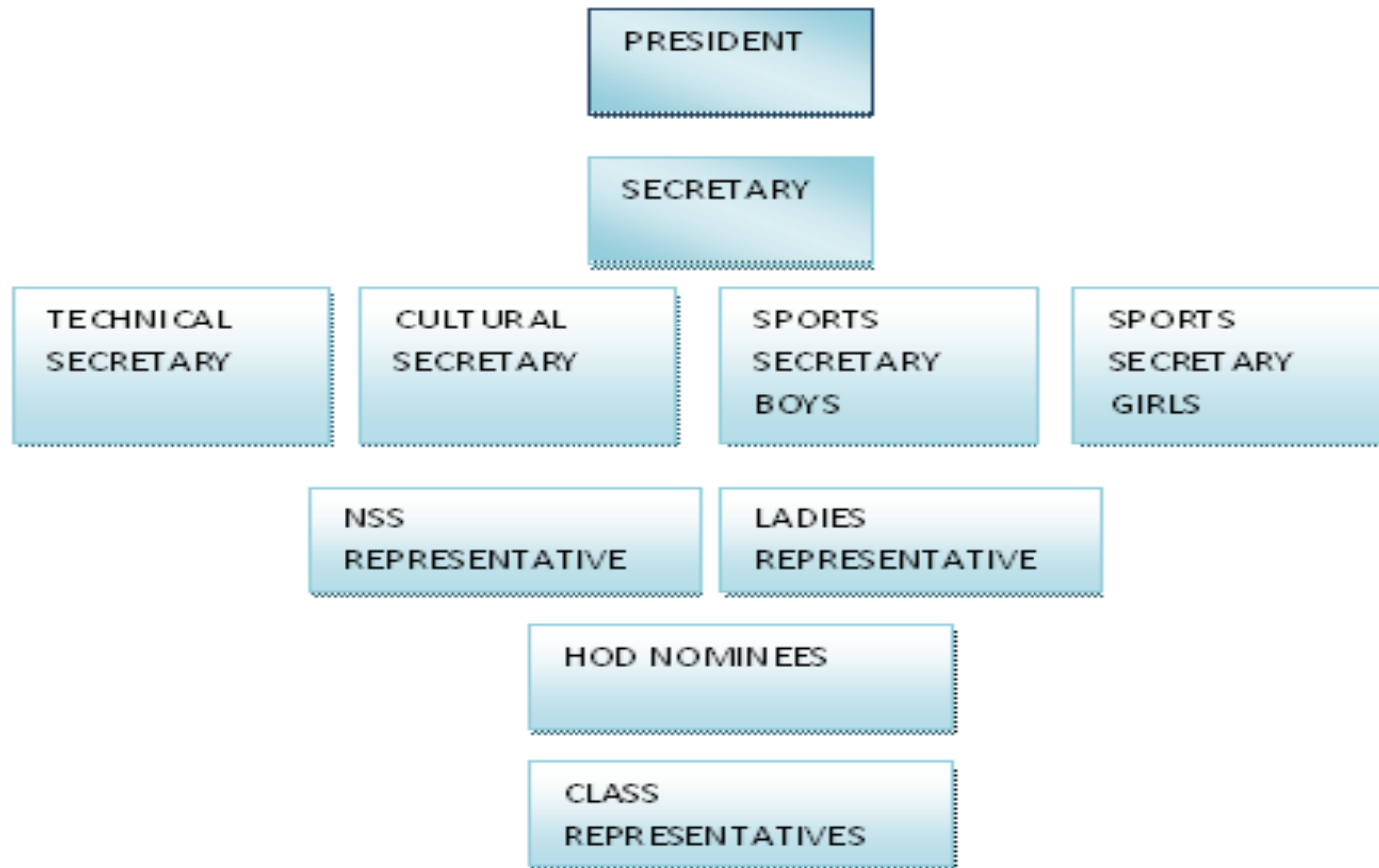
OBJECTIVES OF THE COUNCIL

THE PROCESS-INTERVIEWS AND NOMINATION

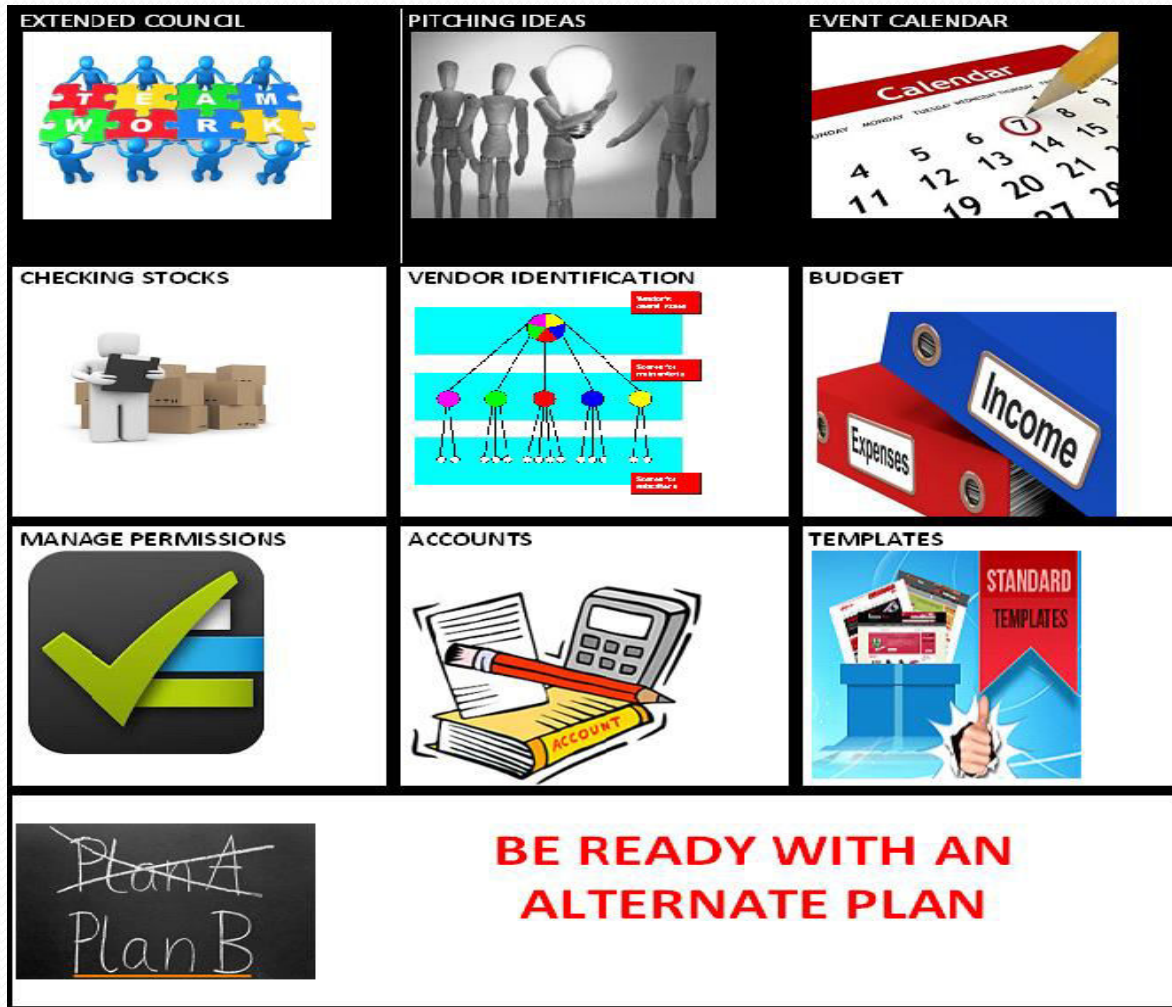
- Appointment by academic merit – **Class Representatives**

- Interview - **Technical Secretary, Cultural Secretary, Sports Secretary, Ladies representative and NSS representative**

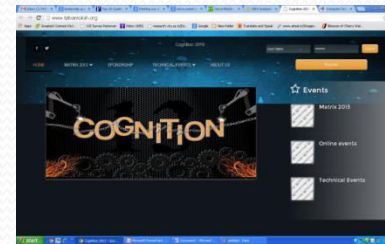
THE PROCESS- VOTING


