- 4) MHT-CET 2021 Score Card & JEE –Main 2021 Score Card as applicable
- 5) School/College Leaving Certificate from the Institution, which the candidate has passed the qualifying examination.
- 6) Domicile Certificate/Nationality Certificate as applicable (Nationality Certificate is mandatory if the student's Nationality is not mentioned in his/her Leaving Certificate).
