The third day of the induction consisted of two seminars on disaster management. At the Auditorium of SIESGST, a seminar was conducted on the importance of first aid. The seminar was inaugurated by Prof. Mahesh Biradar and led by Mohammed Faizan, Manoj Gaikwad and Harshad Patil. The speakers explained the basic terms such as Emergency Medical Services (EMS), Medical First Responder (MFR) and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). Then the speakers talked about important things to remember when calling EMS as well as the cautionary steps to take when administering CPR. The session concluded with a practical session to teach the attendees how to administer CPR. The speakers then later received a memento from the institute.

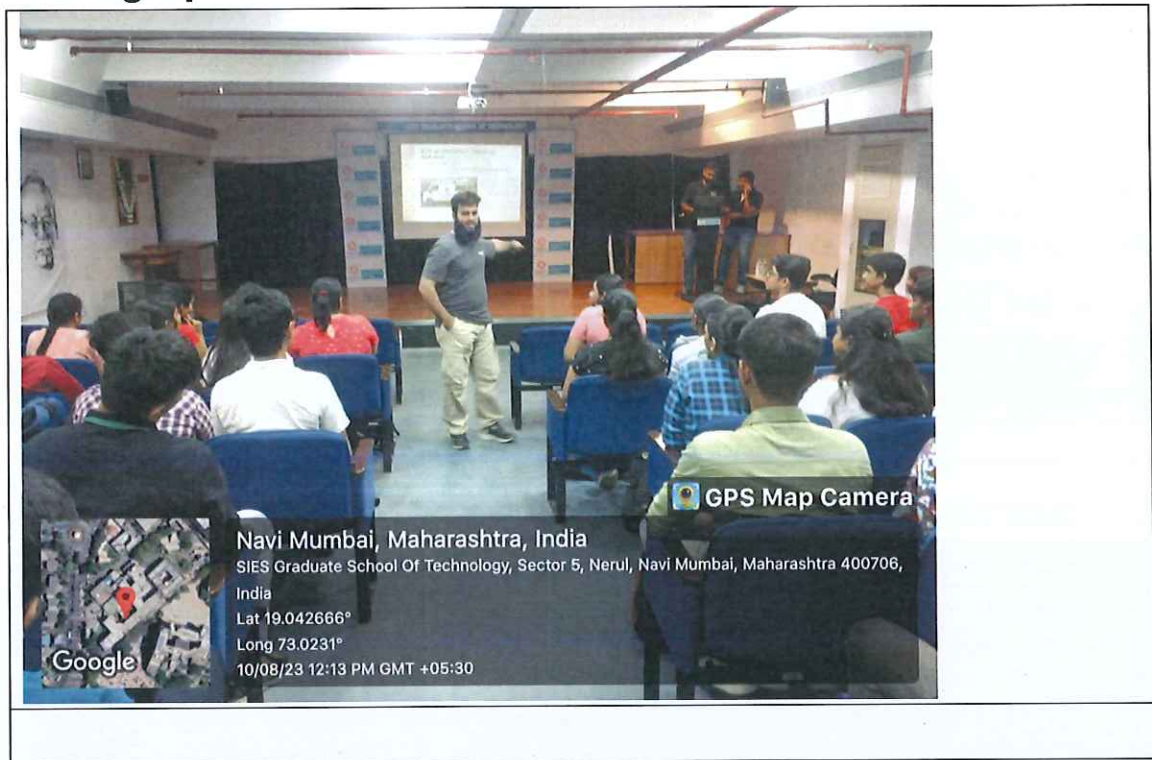
