2. Food Wastage- This part of the skit illustrated the problem of food waste. It was highlighted that many individuals can't afford to eat one meal at a time, while others take too much food on their plates and don't even eat it.
3. Patriotism- The struggles and losses experienced by an army family, as well as how their family dealt with it was depicted in this part.

The skit was performed by NSS volunteers who performed the skit brilliantly and also performed various songs and dances pertaining to the topics. The skit was concluded by the volunteers chanting 'Bharat Mata Ki Jai' and lastly performing the NSS claps as a sign of respect for the audience. Later a speech was given by Mr. Sriram Narayan, an alumnus of SIES GST. The event was concluded with a speech by the Cultural and Literary members.
