# **Event Description**

This year we also had two major prefest events which were held on the 24th and 26th of March 2022. Our first prefest event was "Spotlight". This event was on the lookout for a person with a dynamic personality. It focused on challenging different aspects of the participants' personalities such as getting the participants to do tasks out of their comfort zone and seeing how they adapt to situations. The second event was "Bigg Boss" conducted on 27th March 2022. The participants were divided into 4 major groups and sent to different classrooms where they had to perform fun-filled tasks as a team to get closer to the finale. It was a full-day event that brought out the creative as well as the witty side of all the participants. Tatva Moksh Laksh(TML), our annual festival was celebrated with great enthusiasm and zeal on 31st March and 1st April 2022. The theme for TML this year was Sceneverse - Savour the iridescence. We had organized various events wherein each event was unique in nature, they blended together perfectly to fit the theme in their own ways. Highlight events organized this year include Solo Duet Dance, The Voice, Group Dance, Fashion Show and Abhinaydarshi. Classic events like Treasure Hunt, Instrumedley, Crossfit and Minute to win it, were bigger and better than ever. We introduced new events this year in TML such as Hijack and Breakout. FIFA and BGMI were also organized as a part of LAN events. All the events proved to be a major part of making TML a huge success.

#### **PREFEST EVENTS:**

1) SPOTLIGHT: Spotlight is the contest of wits and personality. Think out of the box, stand a little different and speak out. It was a three day event. On Day One the participants filled a form out of

which 50 participants qualified into round 2. On Day Two Alumni judges were invited who took interviews and made the participants do certain tasks. On the basis of which 30 participants were qualified for Round 3. On day Three there were many fun tasks and games and sub rounds which judged the personality of the participant. 






