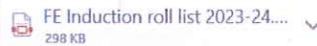

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## Event Description

On August 7th, 2023, a fresh cohort of aspiring engineers entered SIES GST with innovative minds and bright aspirations. These students, brimming with dreams, were introduced to various teams, each representing a unique opportunity for collaboration and growth. This marked the beginning of an exciting new chapter, where these young talents would unite their creativity and technical prowess to make their mark on the world.

### DAY 1 :

On day one, students gathered batch-wise in the GST auditorium for the commencement of their journey at SIES GST. The day commenced with the hosts introducing themselves and the institute's essence to the aspiring engineers. A serene prayer song and a symbolic lamp lighting ceremony marked the auspicious beginning. The Principal of SIES Graduate School of Technology, Dr. K. Lakshmisudha gave an insight about the institute and its rules and regulations. The Advisor Dr. P. Parameswaran guided the students with his words of wisdom. The First Year Engineering Coordinator Prof. Pratibha Sharma provided valuable insights into the first year of engineering, emphasizing the institute's rules and regulations. The student council, led by Dr. Smitha Kumar, shared the significance of the induction program, detailing their roles and responsibilities, along with the institute's vision for holistic student development. The unity and teamwork of the student council were highlighted, underlining its role as a pillar of the institute's character-building efforts over the four years.

### DAY 2:

Two groups were merged into one, such as group 1 and 2 as 1st group, while group 3 and 4 as 2nd group. The 1st group had a Yoga session which was conducted by the NSS UNIT of SIES GST, followed by an English proficiency session. The 2nd group had a Math Proficiency session followed by a UHV session hosted by Mr. Niranjanraj Ramasundaram.

**Yoga Session:** It was conducted by NSS volunteers of SIES GST.

**UHV Session:** This session was hosted by Mr. Niranjanraj Ramasundaram, in this session some important points about mental health and environment were explained to the First years.

**Math proficiency:** This session was organized by the mathematics faculty. In this session the importance and application of math in overall engineering was explained to the First Years. The basics which the students have studied in their 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> standard were brushed up once again.

**English Proficiency:** This session was organized by the Communication Skills faculty. In this session the importance of communication and way of how communication affects a relationship was briefed to the First Years.

**Literary Team:** The Literary Team hosted a meet and greet for first-year students, kicking off with a cheerful warm-up game. They introduced team members and shared insights about The Literary Team's essence, unity, and event highlights. A resume writing workshop emphasized resume importance, followed by a creative activity: crafting resumes for fictional characters. The event



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wrapped up with fun games like "guess the movie" and "create your story," offering an engaging introduction to The Literary Team's dynamic atmosphere.

IETE: The main objective of IETE was to familiarize the FE students and acquaint them with the esteemed faculty, the advantages of being a part of IETE, and the significant workshops and major events conducted by the ISF like Techxter, Ideation, Projection.

The TE and BE Core Members, in addition to briefly introducing each event, engaged the newcomers through a mini-ideation activity to enhance the learning experience. Mini-Ideation Activity: To foster active engagement, the core members orchestrated a mini-ideation activity. FE students were grouped and tasked with solving a simple real-world question and list down the solutions. Guided by the TE and BE core members, the FE students embarked on a journey of collaborative ideation, underscoring teamwork and innovative thinking.

ARENA: The main objective of ARENA was to interact with the students and give them a brief introduction about what is Competitive Programming and Logic Building in general and introduce to them what kinds of events Arena conducts throughout the year. Bug4Ever, Turing Cup, Girls Setter League.

To foster active engagement, the core members orchestrated a small quiz which would put their logic building skills to test. FE students were asked the famous Cake Cutting Question in which they had to mention all the possible ways in which a circular cake could be cut into 8 equal pieces within just 3 chances. Later they were also asked the 4 liters and 3 liters jug question. Some of their students had their answers ready for this however most of them had their logic building skills been put to test.

Cultural Team: The Cultural Team, with a focus on fostering a sense of unity and expression, highlighted Flagship events such as "Riwayat," which encapsulates the cultural diversity through various art forms And traditions. The intricacies of event planning and execution were showcased through events like "Cognition," a technical extravaganza that celebrates intellectual prowess.

One of the most anticipated moments was the revelation of "TML" – "Tatva Moksh Lakshya." TML Launch signifies the unveiling of a much-awaited event. The hosts painted a vivid picture of the Excitement and fervor surrounding the launch, offering a glimpse into the depth of student Engagement.

The presentation seamlessly transitioned into an exploration of the college's cultural clubs, each a Testament to the diverse talents within the student body. "Aaroaha," the Singing and Music Club, Resonates with harmonious melodies. As the day advanced, the stage erupted with a cultural dance performance by Aagmi, an ensemble that transported everyone on a journey celebrating the rich tapestry of cultures. Their dance was an ode to the diversity that unites us all, weaving together traditional elements with contemporary flair. This was a very fun event for the Fes who were introduced to the Cultural Clubs of the college in a very fun and interactive and glamorous way.



**Social Media Team:** The SM team kept a fun and lively interactive session by engaging students in various games. Find the Reel :- everyone was given 5 different riddles from which they have to guess which reel it resembles. Guess the Emoji :- famous Instagram influencers were depicted using emojis and letting fe's guys the name of the influencer. Meme Templates :- trending memes were used on the ppt and letting them guess the meme , while discussing what the meme is all about. Hashtag Game :-everyone in the class has to describe themselves using one hashtag . If someone uses a particular hashtag no one can repeat the hashtag.

They concluded the session by showing some of their work in the past year and addressed any queries.

### **DAY 3:**

**Technical Team:** The Technical Team decided to give out maximum exposure to all the newcomers and welcome them to a technical bachelor's degree program with sessions on introduction to new technology and developing new skills in them. All the members of the Management domain were shortly introduced. They briefly explained the roles of all the domains followed by the main events of the technical team All the App domain members were shortly introduced. Students got to know about App development. They have explained the role of App developers and various technologies used in app development All the Game domain members were shortly introduced. Students got to know about what a game developer is, and the role of a game developer. Robotics and web domain was also introduced. The event ended with a quiz competition held which was based on the information received about the domains.

**IEEE:** First-year students were divided into four groups. Each group of students were addressed with the same enthusiasm. To make the induction fun and interactive, IEEE crafted the games 'ERROR 404' and 'PICTIONARY'. 'ERROR 404' was a code block which had 'Techopedia' , the flagship event of IEEE SIES GST, hidden in it. Top three to guess the word correctly were declared as winners. The second game was 'PICTIONARY' where seven volunteers from the crowd were selected to depict the letters of the word 'EPSILON' which is a three-day long symposium, where experts from the field share their experience.

**E-Cell:** It kicked off with a comprehensive introduction to the E-Cell's mission and objectives, followed by an engaging discussion on past events and notable achievements of its members. Providing a holistic view, the presentation extended to shed light on the Community and Incubation team, showcasing the diverse avenues for student involvement. The latter half of each session was dedicated to an interactive quiz that covered fundamental aspects of startups and renowned brands. This engaging segment allowed participants to showcase their knowledge and enthusiasm in a competitive environment. To celebrate excellence, E-Cell rewarded the top three winners from each group with exciting prizes.

**Team Promethean:** The Promethean team shared an overview of their team, highlighting its purpose, goals, and role within the engineering community. Briefly described the events that their team organizes. Introduced the core members, heads and coordinators of Team Promethean, including their roles, expertise, and their commitment to supporting the first-year students. The team also played the 5 second rule game to lighten the spirits. In the end, the team expressed gratitude to the first-year students



for participating in the induction and for their enthusiasm. At the end the official website was introduced to students, highlighting the various features.

CSI: The CSI Council hosted a technical session on "LinkedIn" for FE students. The session was led by the CSI core members. Students learned how to launch a LinkedIn profile and how to establish and create a network. In order to provide the students with a better understanding, our chairman also showed a real-life LinkedIn profile. Furthermore, a number of aspects of a LinkedIn profile, tools, and certifications supplied by various websites were shown to the students in order to help them improve their profile and entire package.

WORKSHOP SELF DEFENSE: The FE - Induction 2023, witnessed a Self Defense Workshop conducted by the Women's Development Cell. The students were intended to learn fundamental self-defense skills so they could defend themselves in perilous circumstances. The workshop was led by skilled self-defense instructors Mr. Raunak Mookherjee and his assistant trainer Samit. The self-defense training was successful; participants left with increased self-assurance and ability to defend themselves in risky circumstances. The extremely skilled instructors created a welcoming environment for all the attendees.

#### DAY 4:

Sports Team: The sports team of SIES GST conducted three fun activities in this event namely Quiz, React Ball and TT Tapping. Students enjoyed giving the answer to the Quiz. React the Ball is a game in which you should only react when the ball travels towards you. If you react when the ball isn't traveling towards you will be eliminated. TT Tapping is a game in which a student has to tap TT Ball on the TT Bat maximum number of times. The sports team presented a PPT which included all the achievements of the team which was achieved in previous year and also the events of Lakshya that was conducted in the year 2022-23. It also presented the new sports that are going to be added in this academic year. The event ended with the students watching the Aftermovie of all the sports played last year.

Media Team: To establish a strong connection with the incoming students, the Media Team organized a dedicated induction session. This session aimed to introduce the team's mission, responsibilities, and the role they play in enhancing the college experience. In this session, they also taught the basics of camera settings. This helped the newcomers understand how to use cameras effectively. To wrap up, they showed them previous year's TML Aftermovie. This experience not only taught them about media but also sparked their interest in storytelling through visuals. The induction was designed to foster a sense of belonging and to encourage potential members to join them in their media endeavors.

Cultural Team: The induction event which was orchestrated by the Cultural Team unfolded, painting the canvas of diversity and creativity within the gathering. #### **DAY 5:**

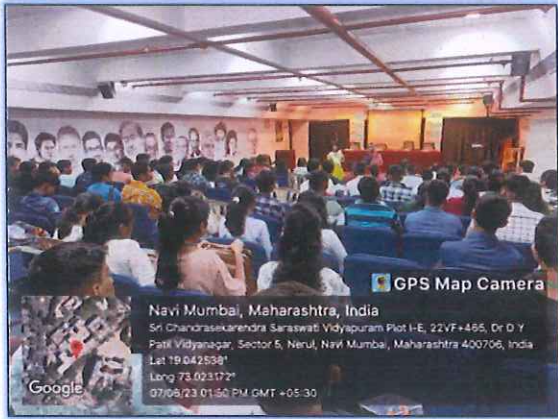
