Event Description

On 26th February 2020, the IEEE SIESGST student council under the WIE affinity group conducted STEM lectures for students in the 6th standard as a mean to inculcate a sense of curiosity and eagerness to learn and discover more about the fields.

The lectures were conducted for students at Shiravane Vidyalaya and Junior college situated in Nerul with prior coordination with the principal and other faculty members at the school. The students of 6th, 7th and 8th were taught Mathematics, Science and Technology respectively and all three classrooms were given an overview of the multiple fields of study under the engineering part of the session. The student body for IEEE assembled at 10:00 am at SIESGST before heading to the school. The lecture began at 11:00 am and was conducted for 90 minutes and concluded at 12:30 pm. The IEEE student council conducted an interactive session in a class with a strength of 60 students where in the students of 6th std. responded to the session positively showing their eagerness to learn more about the subjects.

6th std. students were taught mathematics in which the students were introduced to different techniques of analysis for multiplication, division as well as basic math. Divisibility tests, quick multiplication techniques of multiple types were some of the topics covered. In science, for the 7th std. students, they were introduced to different scientific concepts and given an overview of the subject. The laws of motion, magnetism, and gravity were some of the topics covered during the session. The IEEE student body conducted said lectures with the use of PowerPoint Presentations and videos for better understanding of the concepts. Under technology, the students of 8th std. were introduced to different advancements in technology and its day to day applications and given an overview of the subject. Students were made to interact with each other in discussing the different technologies that were used on a day to day basis. They were also given the opportunity to discuss topics such as robots, computers, rockets and other such advancements in the field of technology. The IEEE student body used the robots built by them in the robotics workshop conducted, as a means to hold an interactive lecture and involve the students in the

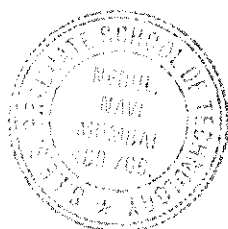

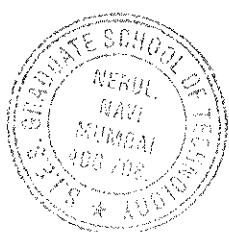
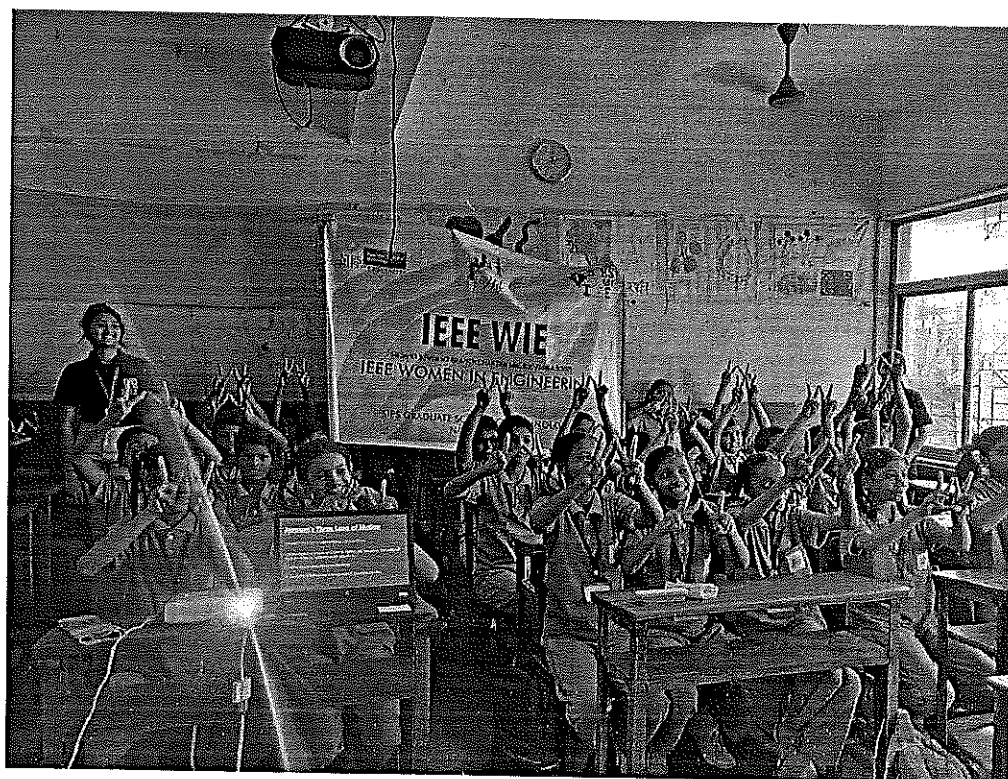
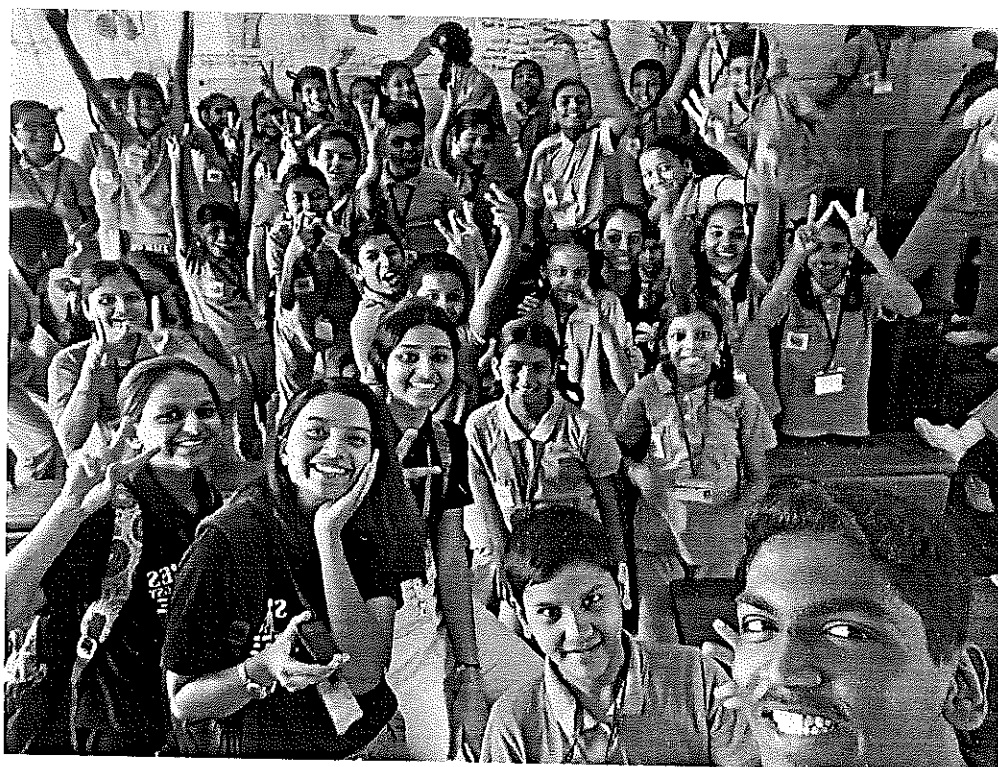
field through inculcating curiosity. At the end of each session the IEEE student body students took a few moments to introduce the different fields of engineering to the students as a basic career guidance session.

Shivaji Jayanti Celebration - 19/02/2020

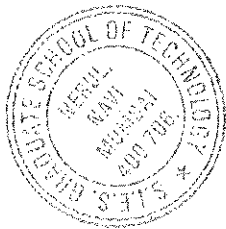

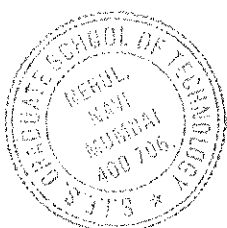
Random act of kindness - 19/02/2020

The volunteers also performed street plays in the village square to raise awareness about topics like:

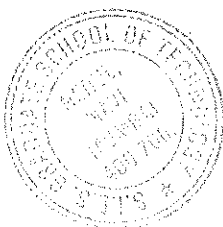

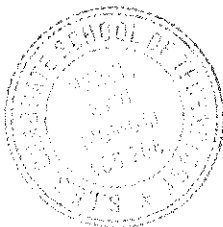
REPORT OF PROMETHEAN 2020: AN ENGINEER'S SOLUTION

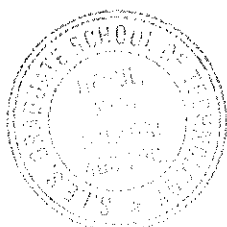
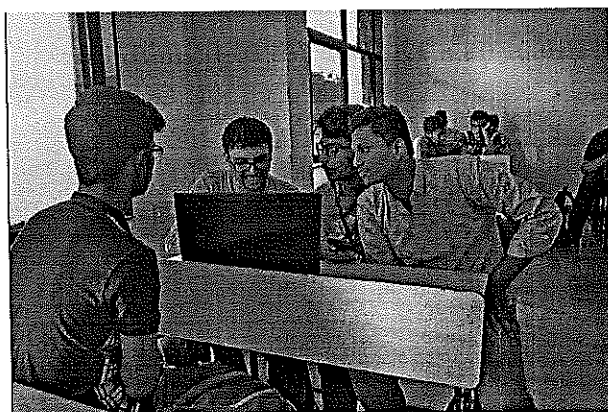
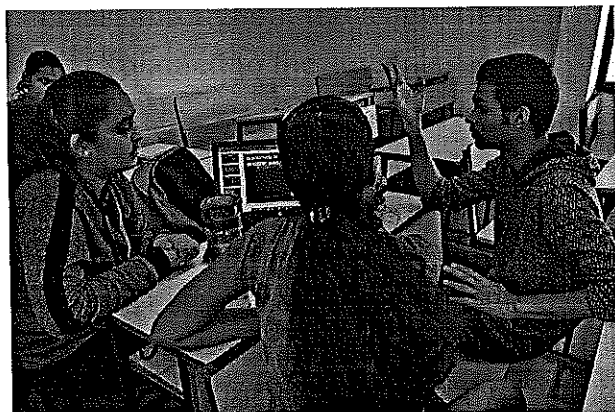
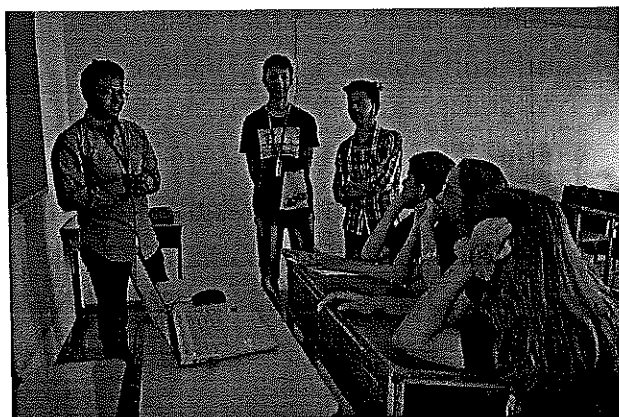
PROMETHEAN WORKSHOPS

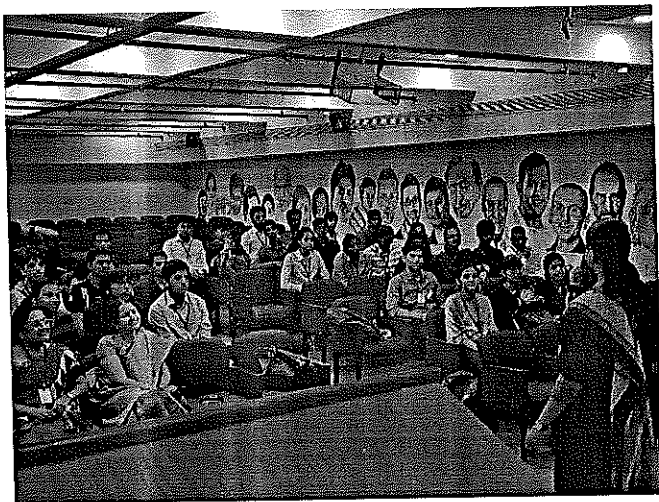
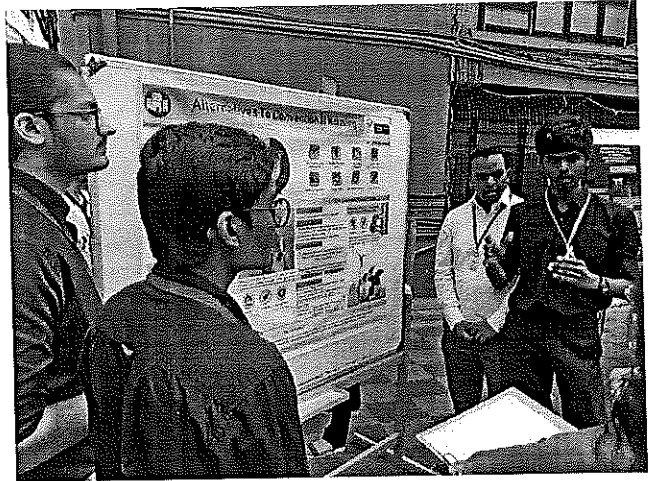
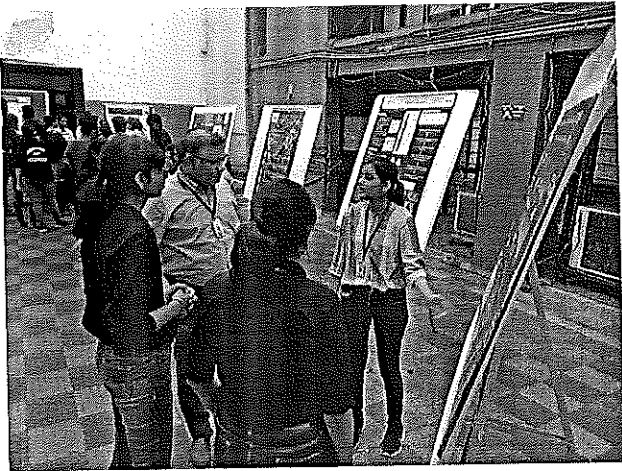
The students explained their solutions through their poster to the judges in detail. The judges questioned the students, where their preparedness was tested.

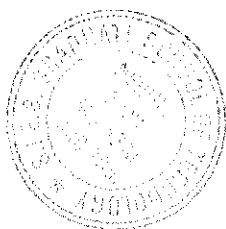
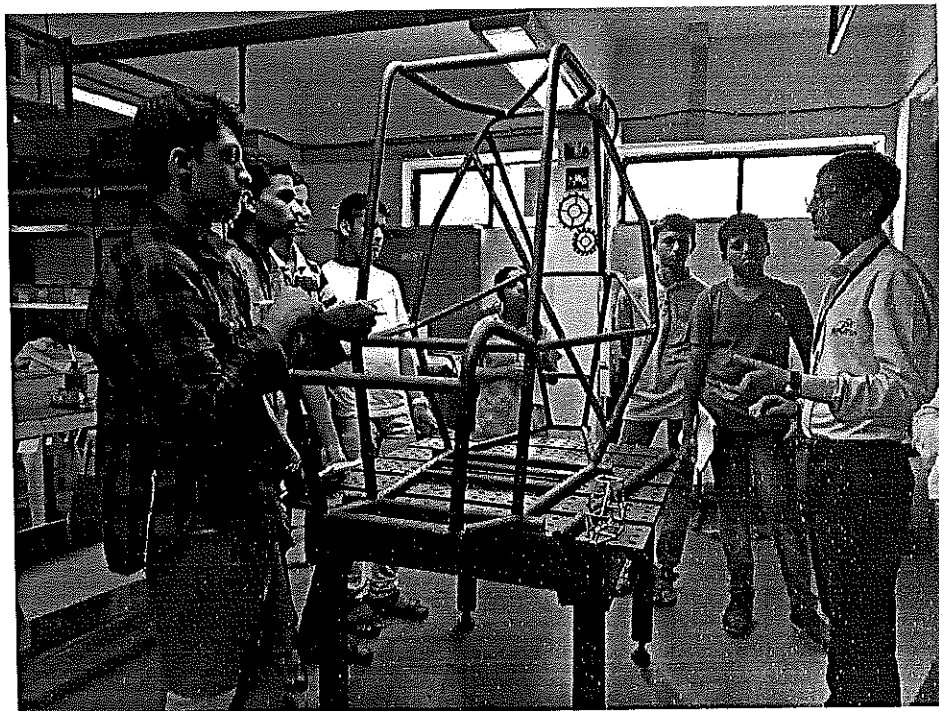
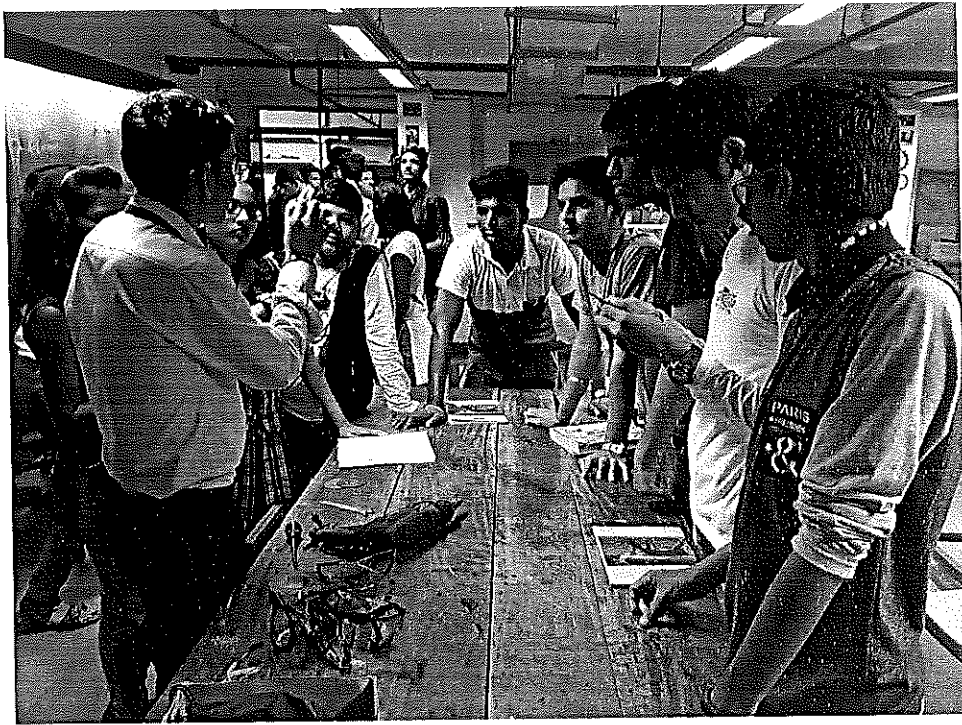
Event Description

Students were provided with various packaging materials and were judged on parameters like less weight of the whole package, durability of the package, design considerations etc.



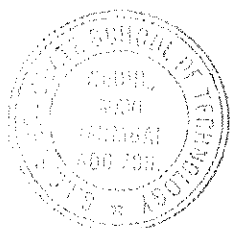

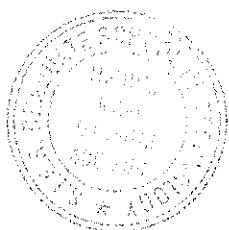
Day 1(22/09/2019):

Day 2(29/09/2019):

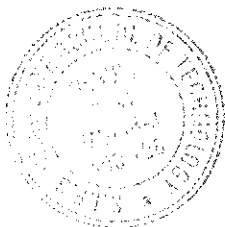
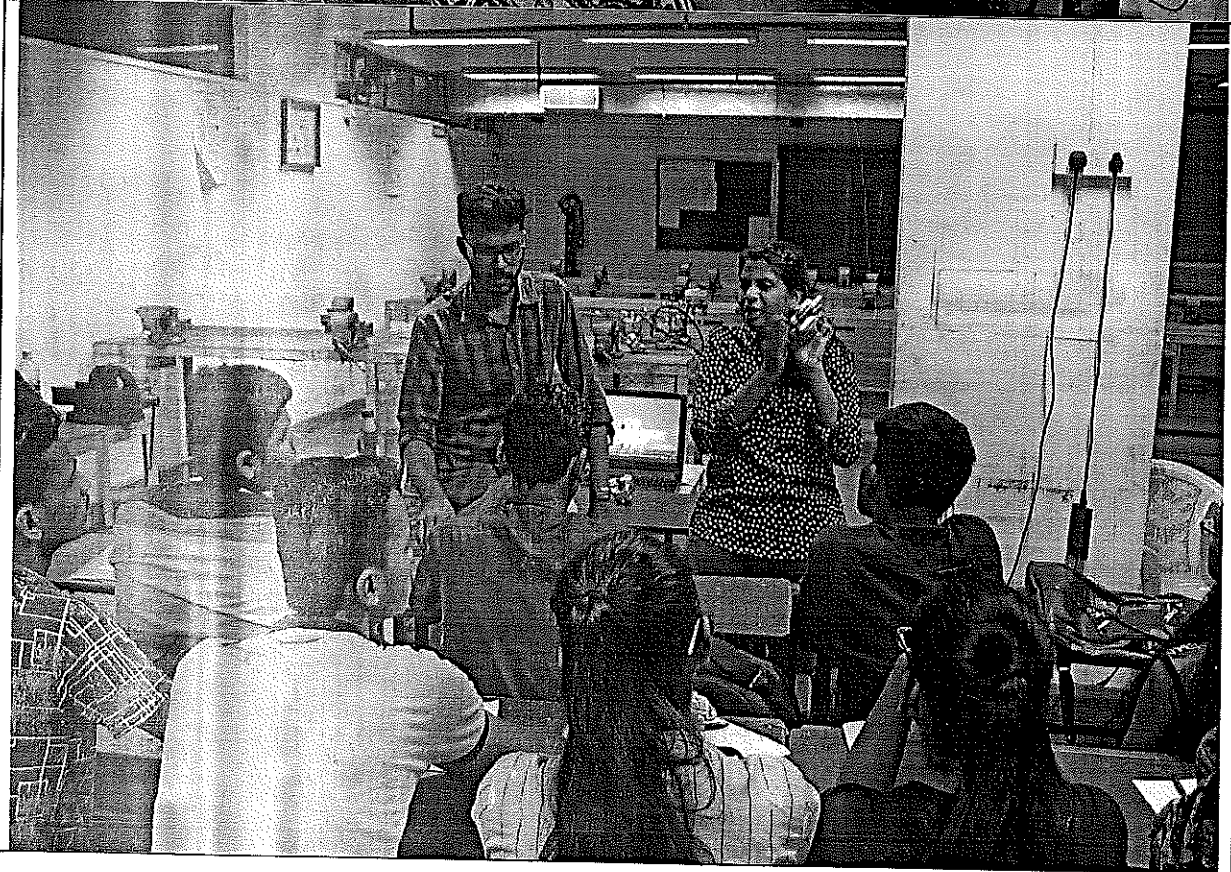
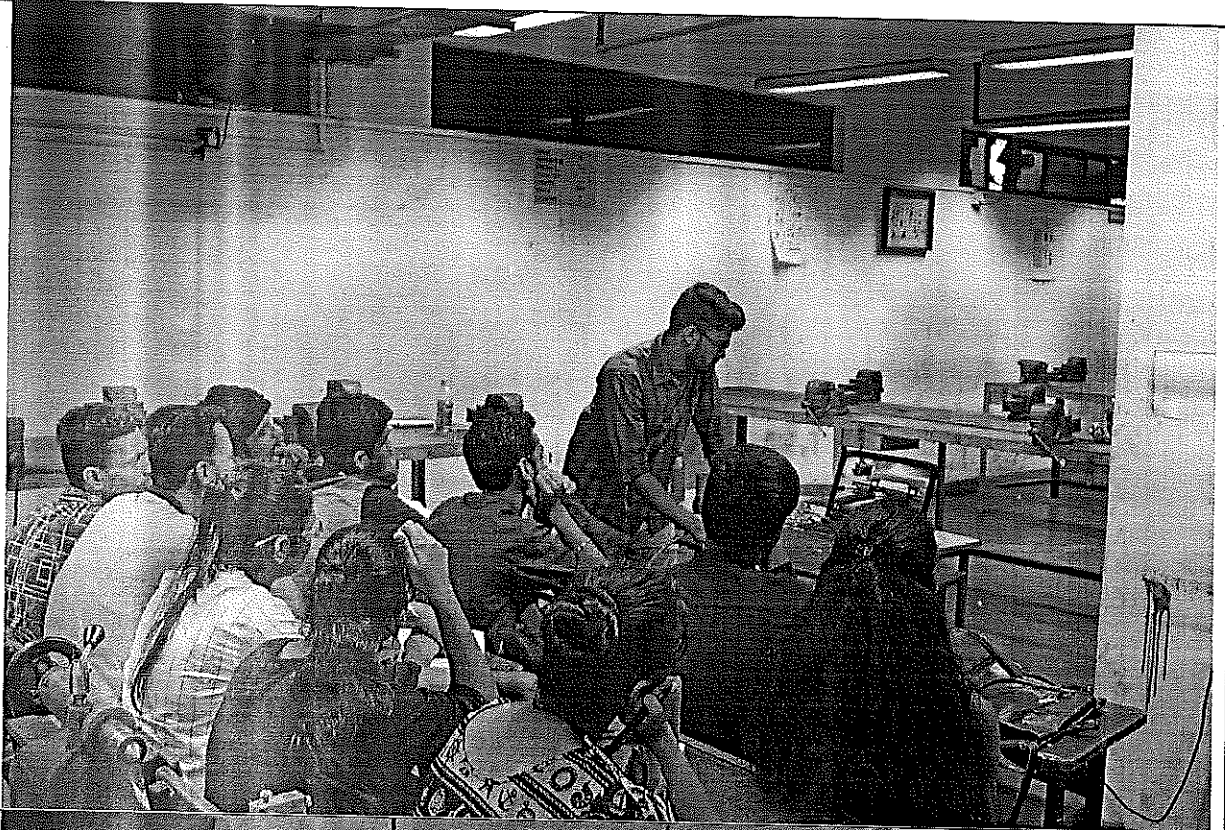

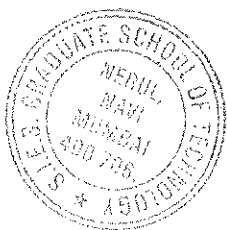
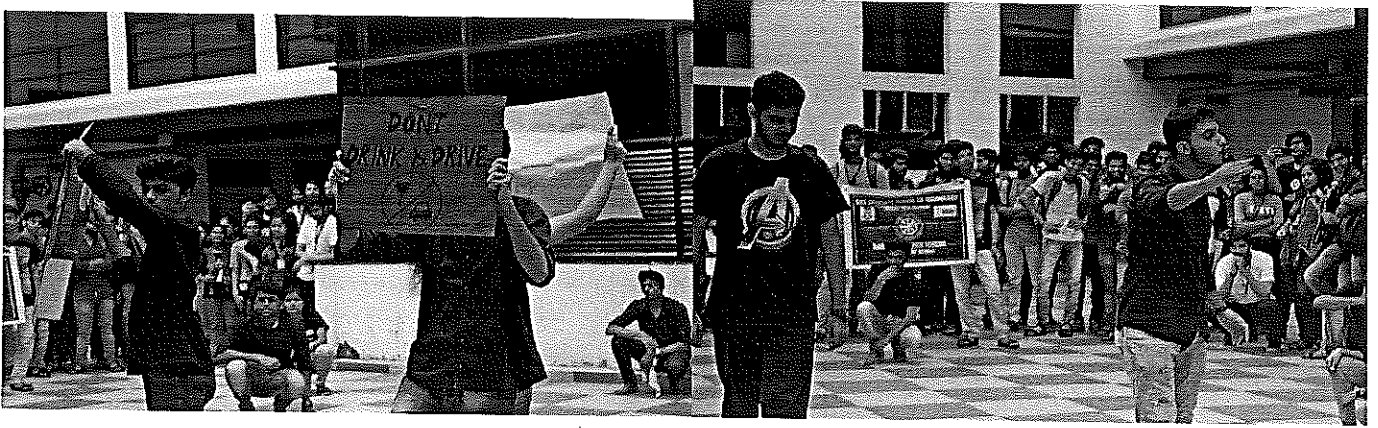
Street Play - 22/09/19 to 24/09/19

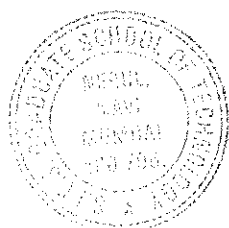
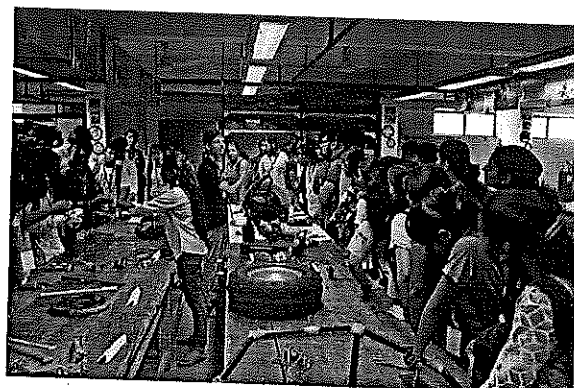
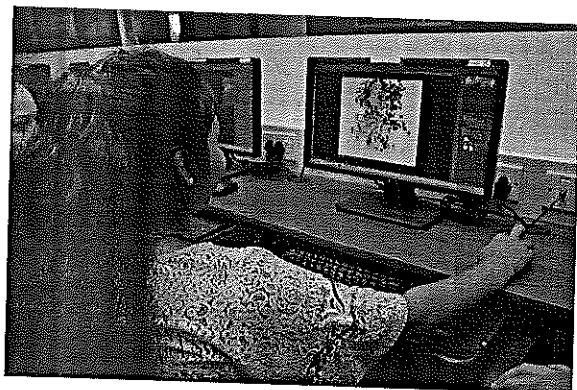


FE Induction - 2019

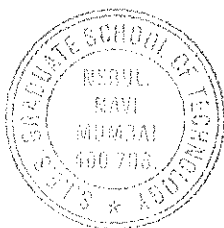
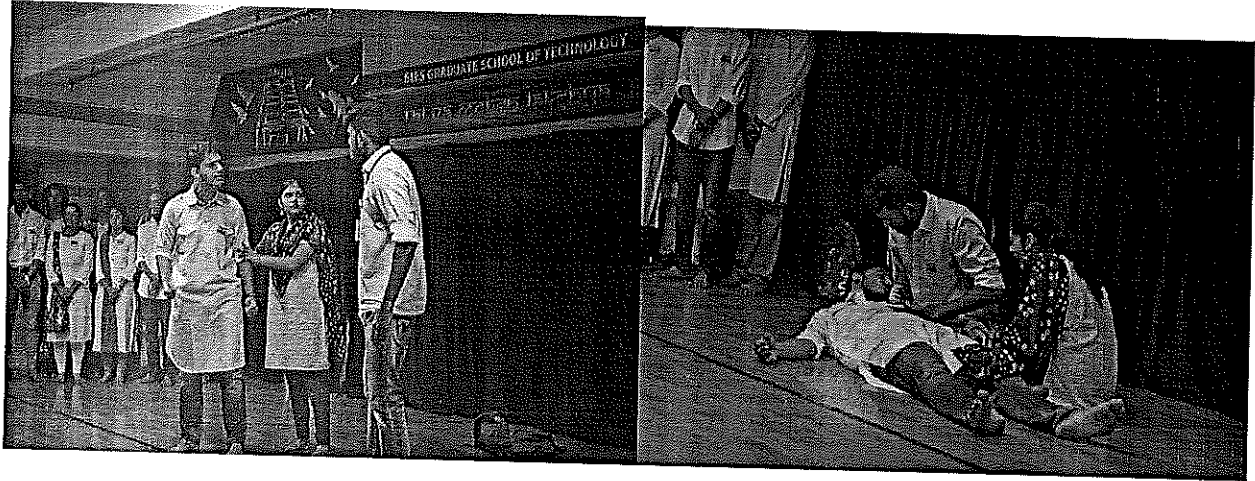
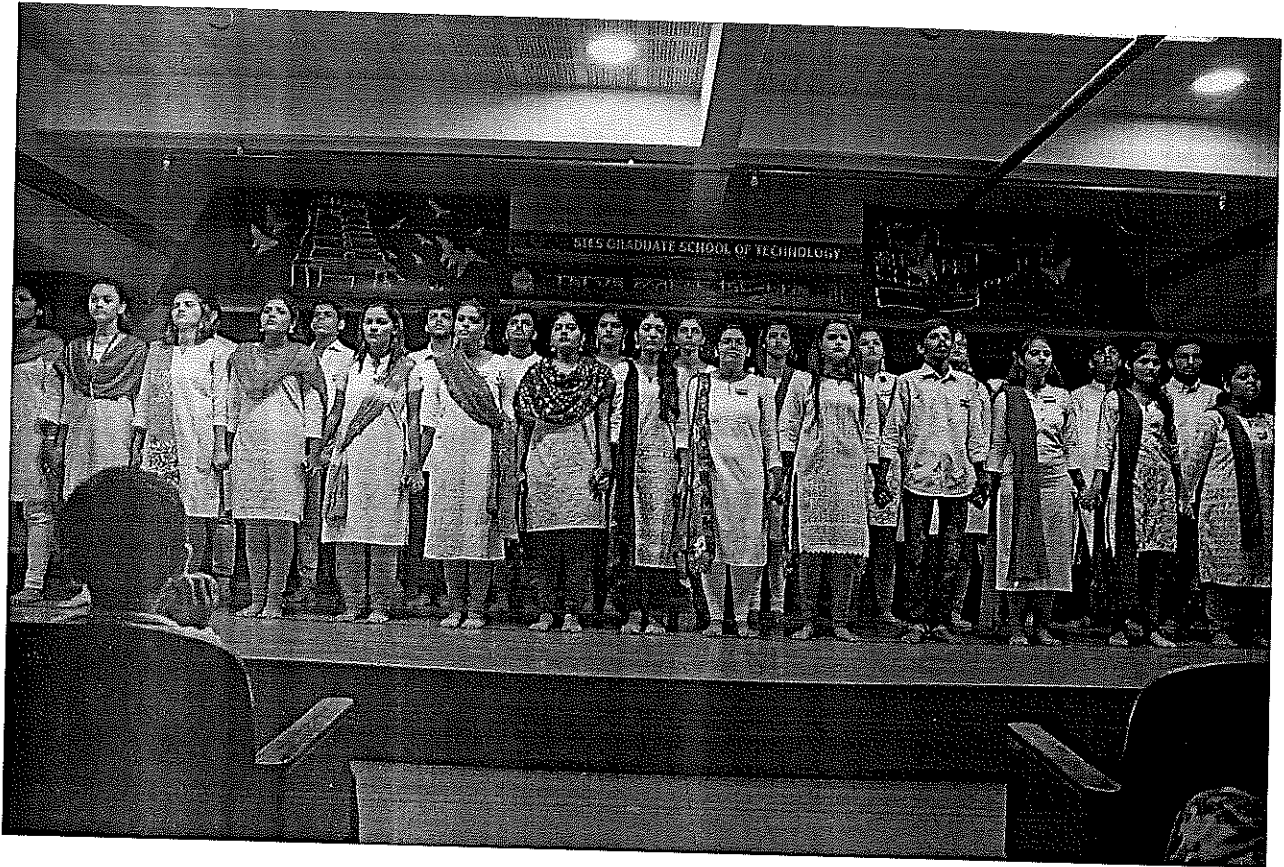
Independence Day Celebration-15/08/2019

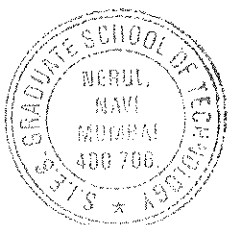
Day 1

Day 2

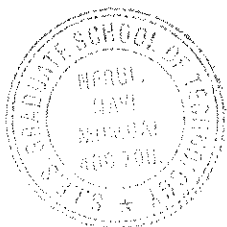
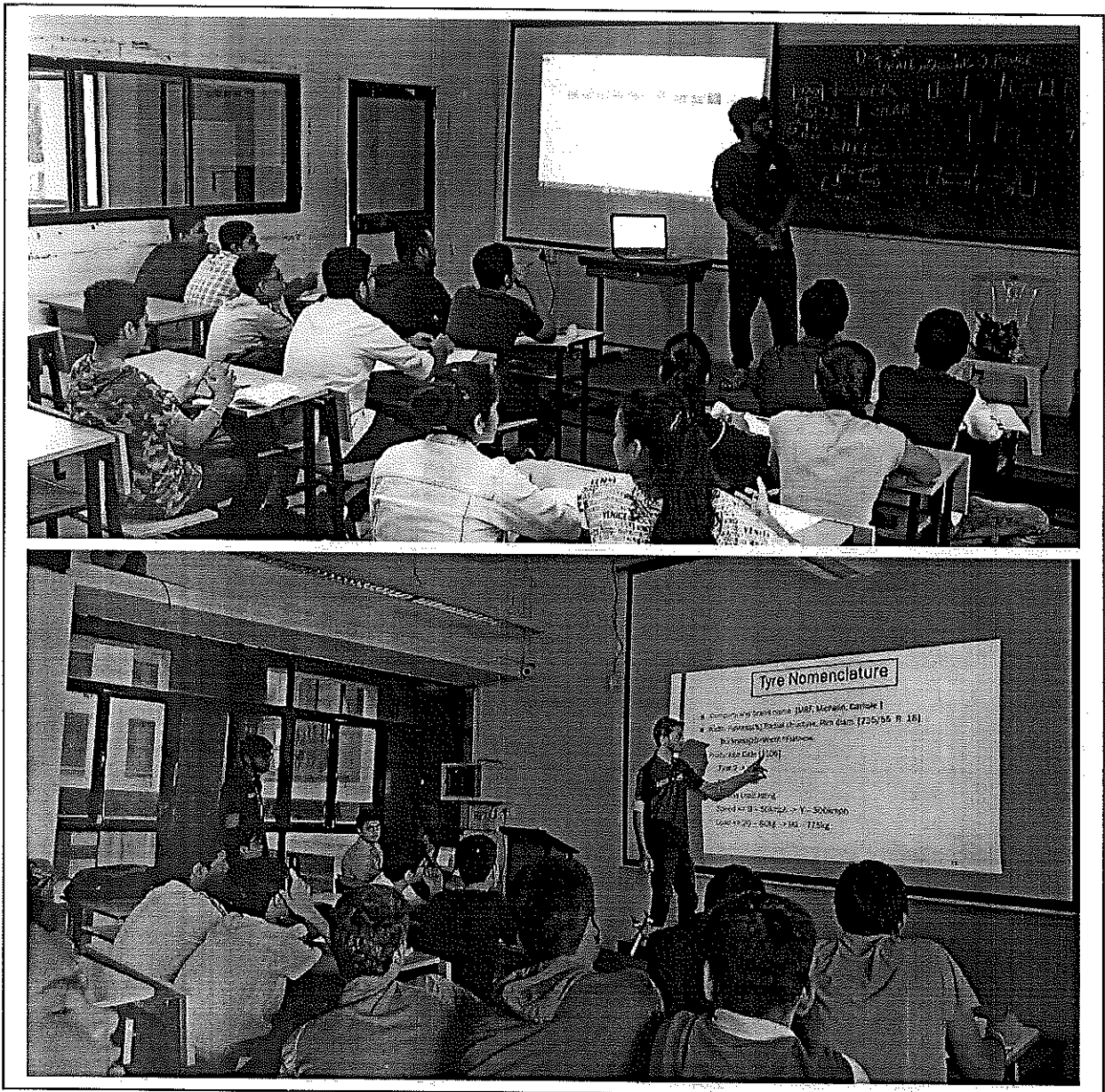

Big Mumbai Clean – up campaign

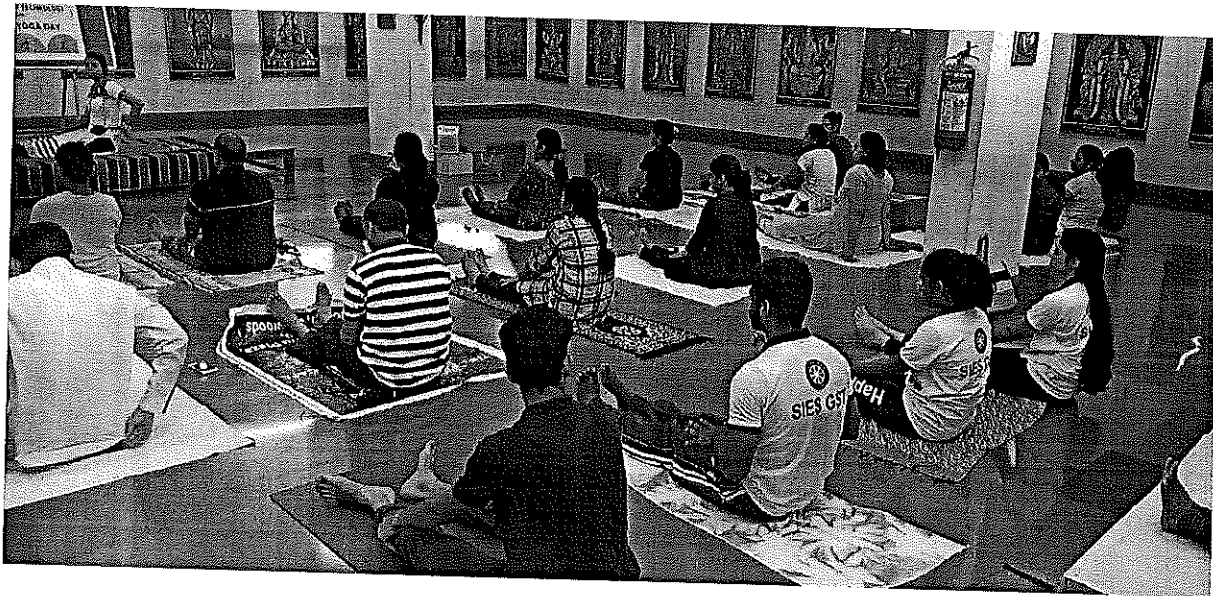
