Shruthi: A SIES GST computer science alumnus from the 2017 batch, Shruthi took a huge leap of faith to the social sector after her graduation.

She is the Fellowship Lead at The Gender Lab, where she empowers young women to go through an immersive leadership journey. She is passionate about social change and designing intersectional feminist spaces. In her free time, she often reads books. She's into writing and playing sports.

Aniket: Engineer and a post graduate in Mathematics by degree, Aniket deviated from the expected course of career. Co-leading the Redefining Masculinity vertical at The Gender Lab, he is on a journey of unlearning and learning gender and what it means to be a man. Apart from critically questioning gender norms, Aniket also loves to listen to all sorts of music and is not half bad on a piano.

Their work with the Gender Lab is empowering adolescent girls in schools with 21st century skills to become changemakers in their community and break gender stereotypes they live in. We deliver this through a fellowship of young women from across India who have themselves battled gender bias growing up. They mentor these girls through 10 months and in turn build leadership and self awareness.

Through this work, we also realized the need of engaging adolescent boys as allies. We create a safe space for them in schools to build awareness around gender, redefine masculinity and engage them in community action.


The seminar commenced with her explaining about the idea of empowerment. Further they explained how a lot of board toppers are girls but that does not reflect in the job market and this is due to cultural expectations of women as homemakers and extreme intra-household inequalities. Then they explained what feminization of poverty is, how women perform 66% of the work but only earn 10% of the income. Further she told the audience how the pandemic has disrupted women's lives with an increase in the number of domestic violence cases.



Stress management is a wide spectrum of techniques and psychotherapies almed at controlling a person's level of stress, especially chronic stress, usually for the purpose of and for the motive of improving everyday functioning. Stress produces numerous physical and mental symptoms which vary according to each individual's situational factors. These can include a decline in physical health, such as headaches, chest pain, fatigue, and sleep problems, as well as depression. The process of stress management is named as one of the keys to a happy and successful life in modern society. Life often delivers numerous demands that can be difficult to handle, but stress management provides a number of ways to manage anxiety and maintain overall well-being.

Despite stress often being thought of as a subjective experience, levels of stress are readily measurable; using various physiological tests, similar to those used in polygraphs.

There are several models of stress management, each with distinctive explanations of mechanisms for controlling stress. Much more research is necessary to provide a better understanding of which mechanisms actually operate and are effective in practice.

The seminar commenced with the explanation about What is Stress? What are the Signs of Stress? She gave us insights about how we should manage and prevent stress, and told us about How Stress can be diagnosed. Towards the end, she explained how we should manage and prevent stress.

It was a two-day international relations conference for students conducted offline, SIES GST MUN has been getting bigger and better every year.
