

2. INSTITUTION/NSS UNIT LEVEL- Organisation of Cleanliness Drive on 19th Oct, 2022 by all Institutions /NSS units - All NSS Volunteers of every Institution /NSS unit shall be involved & 1.5 Kg Plastic waste to be collected by each NSS Volunteer- Cleanliness-Plastic Collection Drive to be organised in nearby area/Institutions or important Public Places, Monuments .

The College NSS units are requested to direct NSS Volunteers to collect the Plastic Waste from their Homes or at neighboring places at Municipal/panchayat/Waste Deposit Points and obtain certificates. The entire program on 19th Oct, 2022 may be conducted as ..


- a) Symbolic part-at Household/town/institutions etc and

Event Descriptions

Mangrove Cleaning-11th December 2022

The NSS Unit of SIES Graduate School of Technology conducted a Mangrove Cleaning Drive on the 11th of December 2022 at the Sagar Vihar, Vashi. This activity was carried out by The NSS Unit of SIES GST, Nerul.

The cleaning drive commenced at 8:00 A.M. with Rohit sir, who guided the volunteers about the importance of mangroves in the eco-system as well as how we humans are degrading these over a period. The volunteers were all upbeat and energetic, as a result, they stepped into the ground with the goal of removing as much unwanted trash from the mangroves as possible, including plastic materials, bags, shoes, wooden objects, glasses, and many more items that typically take millions of years to decompose and therefore affect aquatic life.

Volunteers followed the policy of collecting the waste into waste, that is, no plastic bags were used to collect the garbage collected from mangroves instead of it the waste bags that were found in the mangroves were used to collect all the small items in it. This drive was carried out for 2 hours, in which tons of garbage was collected.

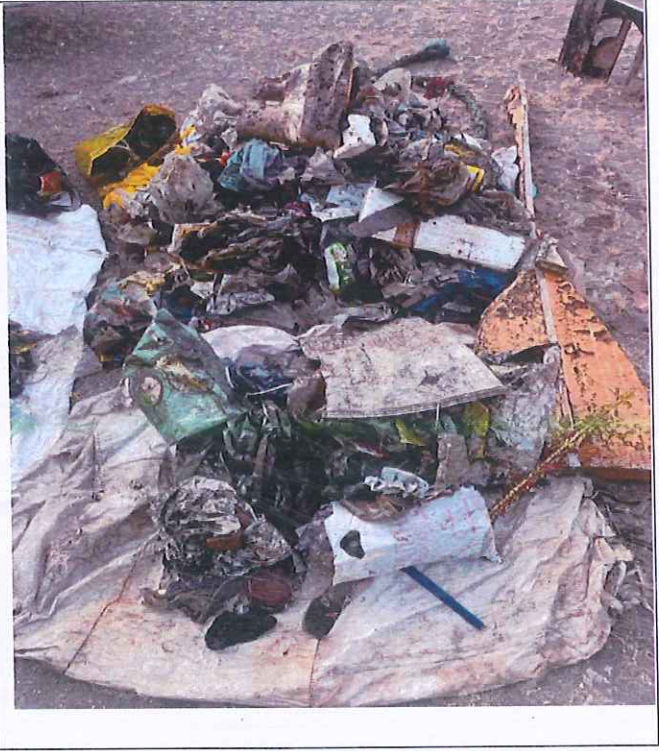
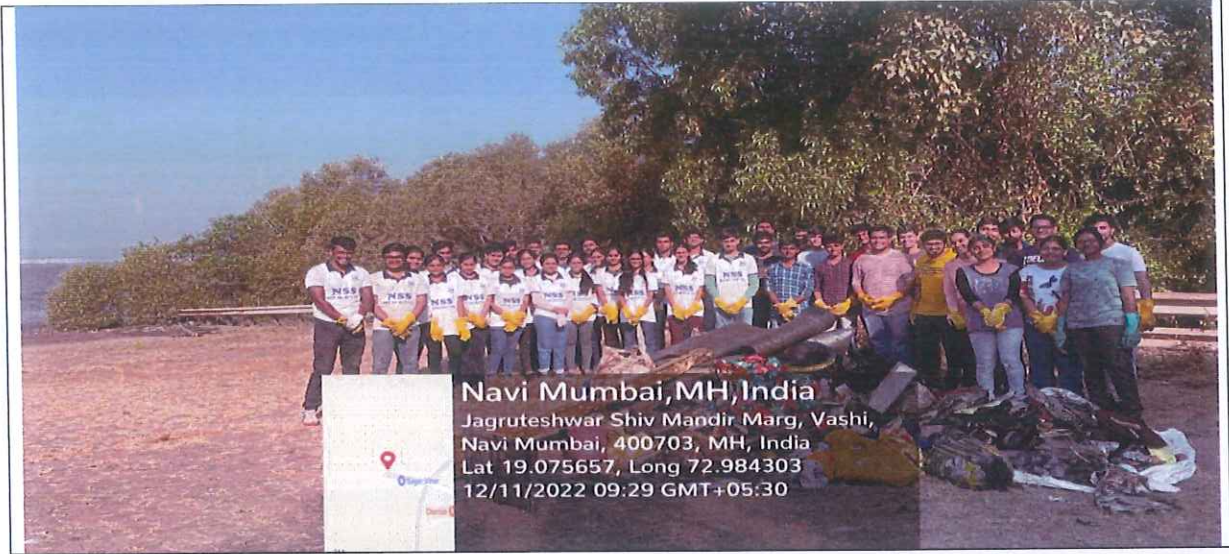
In total, 700 kilos of waste was collected from the mangrove and handed over to the Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation. As the cleaning initiative ended, each volunteer was moved by a desire to prevent littering and to encourage others to do the same because this drive was an eye-opener to how the biodiversity and eco-system are deteriorating due to inadequate waste management and segregation by the people.

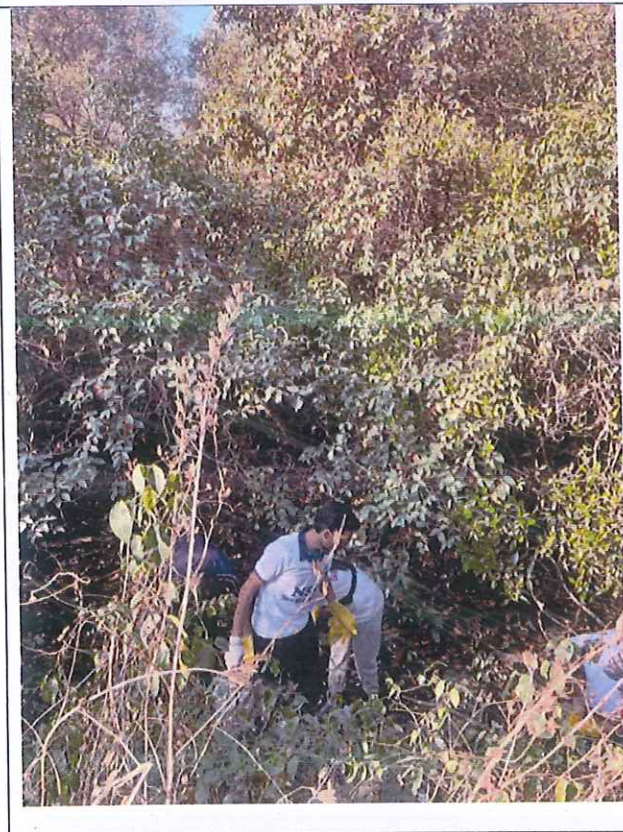
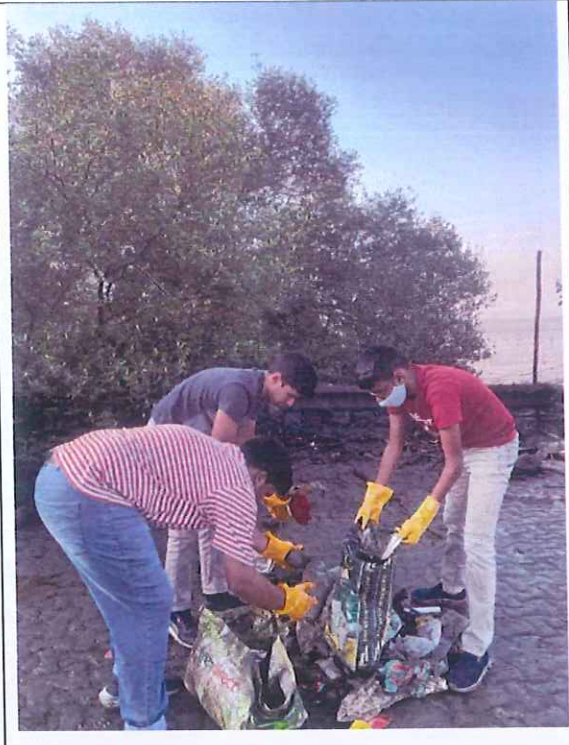
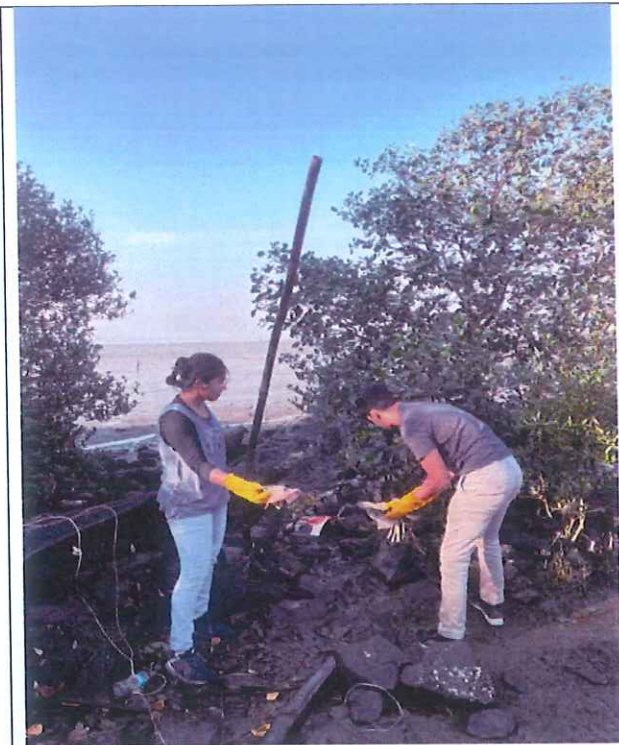
