- 3. Patriotism- The struggles and losses experienced by an army family, as well as how their family dealt with it was depicted in this part.



The TE unit of SIESGST also visited Mumbai CST for bhajan which was been organized by Mumbai University which started around 3:30 PM.







Mangrove Cleaning-11th December 2022

The NSS Unit of SIES Graduate School of Technology conducted a Mangrove Cleaning Drive on the 11th of December 2022 at the Sagar Vihar, Vashi. This activity was carried out by The NSS Unit of SIES GST, Nerul.

The cleaning drive commenced at 8:00 A.M. with Rohit sir, who guided the volunteers about the importance of mangroves in the eco-system as well as how we humans are degrading these over a period. The volunteers were all upbeat and energetic, as a result, they stepped into the ground with the goal of removing as much unwanted trash from the mangroves as possible, including plastic materials, bags, shoes, wooden objects, glasses, and many more items that typically take millions of years to decompose and therefore affect aquatic life.

Volunteers followed the policy of collecting the waste into waste, that is, no plastic bags were used to collect the garbage collected from mangroves instead of it the waste bags that were found in the mangroves were used to collect all the small items in it. This drive was carried out for 2 hours, in which tons of garbage was collected.

In total, 700 kilos of waste was collected from the mangrove and handed over to the Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation. As the cleaning initiative ended, each volunteer was moved by a desire to prevent littering and to encourage others to do the same because this drive was an eye-opener to how the biodiversity and eco-system are deteriorating due to inadequate waste management and segregation by the people.


Impact Analysis:





Event Description

The Special Residential Camp organised by the NSS Unit of SIES GST was held from 3 January to 9 January 2023. Volunteers had to assemble at the Thane station at 7am. Once all the volunteers were present, we boarded the train to Asangaon. As soon as we reached Asangaon we boarded the bus to reach our destination which was Veluk village. The duration of the journey was for 2 hrs. After reaching the location we loaded our luggage in the gram panchayat office. All the arrangements were made by the seniors (Obs).

Later all of us were divided into groups and were allotted their respective duties. The distribution of the duties was according to the kitchen team, admin team, lost and found team, cultural team, and sports team. We went for a village tour to get a lay of the land. All of us communicated with villagers and introduced ourselves. We visited the proposed place where the dam was supposed to be constructed. We head back, had dinner, and wrote down all the things that happened in the day. We were asked to maintain a diary to record all our experiences. The next day we woke up at 4am. We started our day with NSS geet followed by jogging and exercise. We cleaned the school and its surroundings. The hallways and the classrooms were cleaned as well so we could sleep and keep our luggage. Later we were told to make pairs and were asked to communicate and build a bond with the villagers. So that we could know their problems and try to solve them. There was a language barrier as many of us did not have fluency in Marathi. All of us tried our bests to communicate.

During the initial days, we learnt about our surroundings and tried getting used to everything. We were divided into two groups – first group was digging and collecting the soil and plucking the grasslands. The second group was focusing on collection of stones and planning the formation of the dam. We had to lift 10 cans of water every day for our daily use. The main roles were digging team and transportation team. The actual work started from day 3. We had to dig the soil and refine the soil and fill it up in the sacks. This work was continued for the whole day and we had filled around 90 sacks. Our target was to complete around 400-500 sacks with only a few days left in hand. The next day our super seniors had arrived. They gave us immense motivation and confidence. There was a healthy competition between the digging team and the transportation team as who was more agile in their work. We achieved a target of 230 sacks today. Nobody could believe that we could have achieved it. This was only possible because of the guidance and encouragement of the seniors and the super seniors. And because of the combined effort and willpower of everybody involved.

As we were coming to the end, we had to stitch the sacks and transport it near the river for the construction of the dam. Sarpanch, Civil engineer officer and the other staff helped by guiding us in the construction of the dam. The digging team, transportation team and the stitching team were working vigorously. At last, the target was achieved. All of them had tears of joy and happiness. With the help of seniors and super seniors the dam was constructed. We also performed a street play for the villagers to spread awareness on taboo topics and provide accurate information. At night we had a bonfire which was a surprise for us. On the last day, we enjoyed ourselves. The best group was awarded a reward. We received our NSS batches that we were eagerly waiting for. We all packed our luggage's and head back to Mumbai with tons of memories and lessons worth a lifetime.





The water was limited, there was no access to mobile phones and the volunteers had to work in the scorching sun to build the dam. It brought about a realization of the privileged lives we lead and how we sometimes take things for granted. Cooking our own food from scratch, building a dam by digging mud, filling it in sacks, sewing it, placing it on the river bed and stacking them up to build the dam, cleaning the village and doing some much more. Each task taught us something new and it took the effort of the entire unit to successfully complete them. We also performed a street play for the villagers to highlight taboos topics to spread awareness and clear any misinformation.

1) Eligibility Criteria

Q.1 Who is eligible for enrollment as a Voter?

Ans:

- (a) Each Citizen who is 18 years of age on the qualifying date which is first January of the concerned year, except if excluded is qualified to be enrolled.
- (b) Enrolment only at an ordinary place of residence.
- (c) The name should not be present in the electoral roll anywhere.
- (d) An Overseas Indian who has been at the passport address as an ordinary resident.
- (e) Service Voters deemed to be ordinarily resident at their home address.

Q.2 What is the relevant date for determining the age eligibility of 18 years?

Ans. 1st January of the applying year will be the determining date for the eligibility of 18 years. This same date is considered for the revision of the electoral roll as per Section 14 (b) of the R. P. Act, 1950.

Q.3 Suppose I have completed 18 years of age today. Can I get myself registered as voter.?

Ans: It depends on your date of birth. An applicant age is considered as eligible to apply for voter ID if only he/she became 18 years old on the 1st January of the applying year. As the electoral roll gets revised on the 1st January of every year.

2) Required documents

Q.4 What proof of residence do I need to submit to get enrolled as a voter?

Ans: You can submit any proof of residence as listed below.

- Bank/Kisan/Post Office current Passbook
- Ration Card
- **Driving License**
- Indian Passport
- Income Tax Return filed/Assessment Order
- Latest Rental Agreement
- Latest water/ Telephone/ Electricity/ Gas Connection Bill
- Postal department's posts received/delivered in the applicant's name at given address.

Q.5 What are the documents that can be considered as the date of birth proof?

Ans: Any Govt id or Govt approved document which is validating to your age or Date of Birth can be considered as proof of age or date of birth. You can submit any proof of residence as listed below:

- Aadhaar Card
- PAN Card
- Driving License
- Indian Passport
- Marksheet of Class X/Class VIII/Class V, if it contains Date of Birth
- Birth Certificate from the school/other educational institution (Govt./Recognized), last attended
- Birth Certificate issued by a Municipal Authorities
- Registrar of Births & Deaths
- Baptism certificate

Q.6 Is a documentary proof of age required in cases where the age of the applicant is more than 21 years?

- Ans. Documentary proof of age is required only in those cases, where the age of the applicant is between 18 and 21 years. In all other cases, an Age declaration can be taken from the applicant as proof of age.
- Q.7 An applicant who is of 18-21 years of age doesn't have any documentary proof of age/date
 of birth. What paper is he required to attach with his application form for registration as an
 elector?
- Ans. In case none of the documents is available with an applicant who is of 18-21 years of age, a declaration in the prescribed format available on others category as Annexure—I, which should be made by either of the parents of the applicant (or by guru in case of an elector in transsexual ('others') category) can be given.

This activity proved very insightful to NSS volunteers by knowing and embracing our Heroes on their Special Day.


