The following events have been organized under WDC for the year 2023.

FE INDUCTION- SELF DEFENSE WORKSHOP:-

The Women's Development Cell held a Self Defense Workshop for FE - Induction 2023, aimed at teaching students fundamental self-defense skills. The workshopwas led by skilled instructors, Mr. Raunak Mookherjee and his assistant trainer Samit.
