



It is important to realize that any trainer needs two separate sets of skills and knowledge.

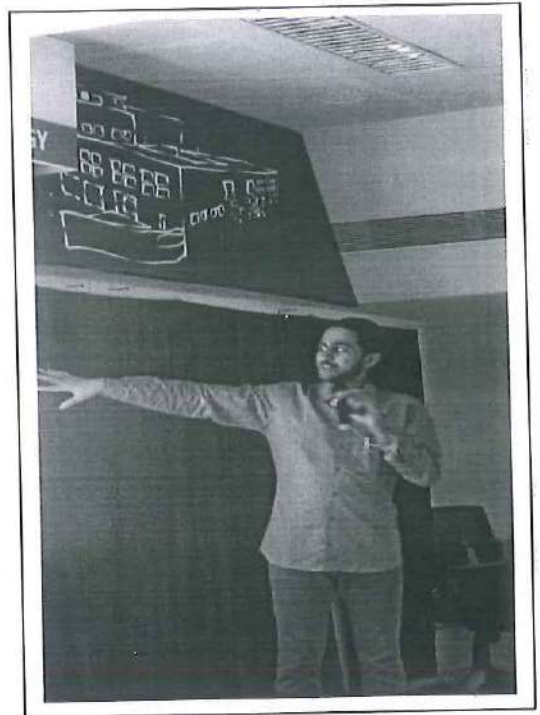
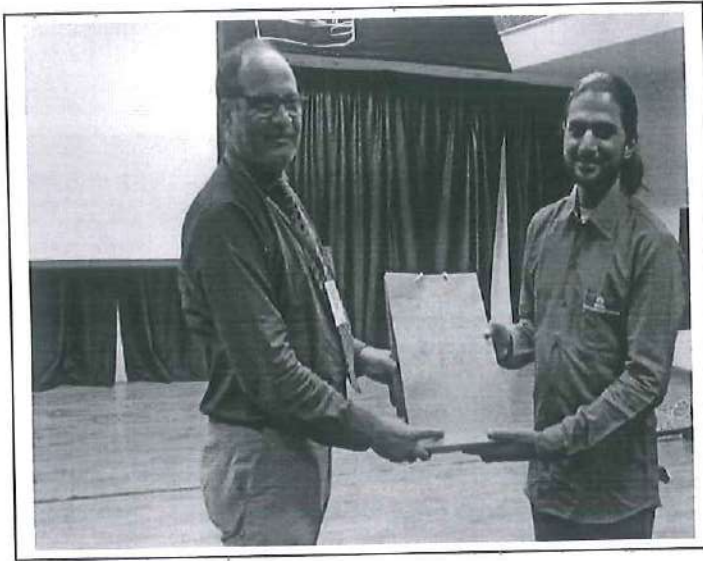

On the second day different codelabs sessions were conducted on the following topics:

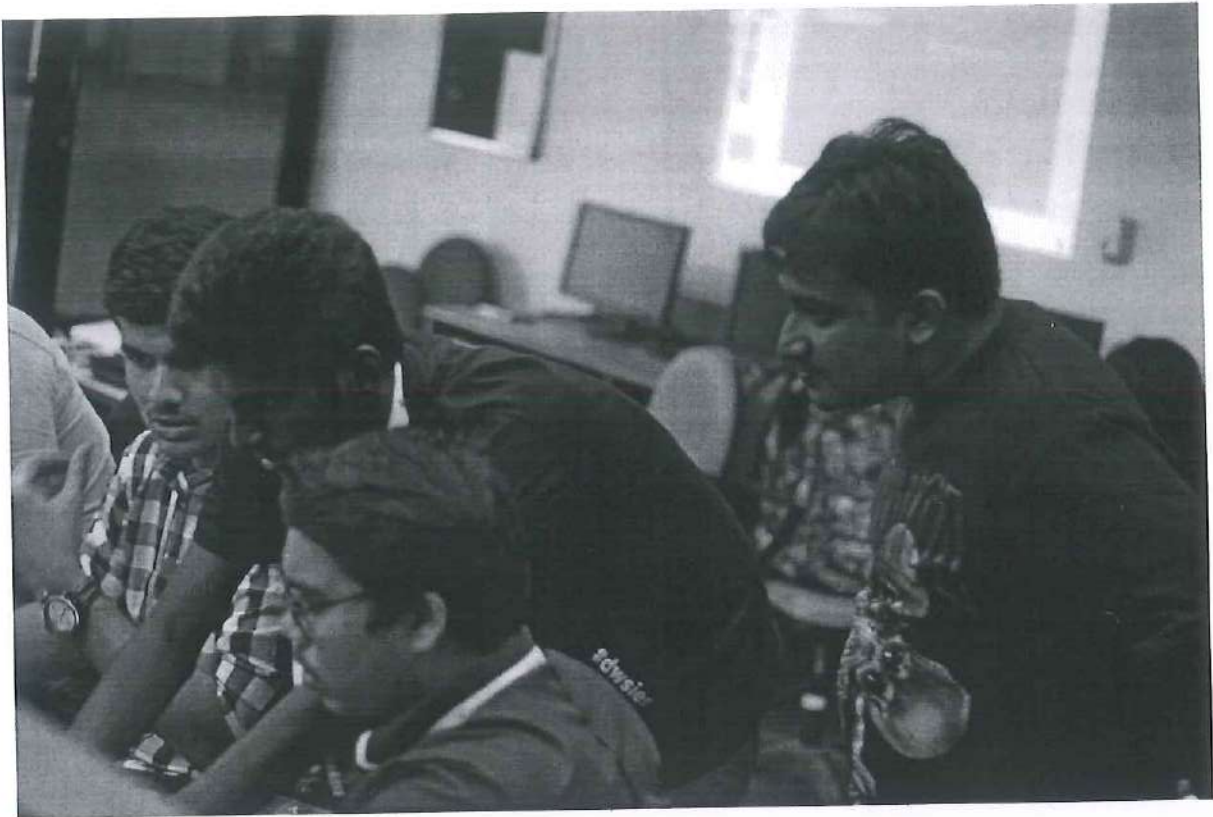

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Event Description

Paradigm 2018 was a three day literary fest conducted on the 24th, 25th and 26th of September which saw 3 different speakers deliver sessions on multitudinous topics from the potential of the digital media, the value of networking to the art of micro-fiction.

The fest began with a session on "Content Writing and the Power of Social Media" by our alumnus Mr. Adarsh Singh. Having had a stint as a Social Media Head during his time in college and currently Content Writer & Marketeer at *WisdmLabs*, he was aware about how to make the best use of various digital platforms. The session covered a wide range of topics such as the difference between 'copy-writing' and 'content writing', how to identify a target audience and how not to sell your product. He introduced students to the two types of marketing strategies namely-organic and paid. The session was laced with fun videos such as the 'Backpack Kid' and activities including some like when a volunteer was asked to sell a Dairy Milk to another member of the audience.

On the second day was a session on "Improving Soft Skills and Market Value" by Mr. Vinay Hegde. As a co-founding member of *AutoNxt Automation Pvt Ltd.* which he helped set up along with his batchmates, he understands the importance of having good contacts and emphasised that the students must focus on having a wider network of friends and accomplices which is crucial in today's corporate world. On improving one's market value, Vinay says that it is recommended that one validates his/her talents. This validation can be done with the help of internships or projects, even in a non-technical field. The highlight of the session was the jam session along the lines of National Level debate competitions like Squabble. In this activity, a volunteer was asked to speak on any topic of his/her choice. If the person makes a grammatical or factual error or runs out of words; one of the other volunteers may object and the first one raise an objection gets to speak on a topic of their choice. This activity helps one in becoming articulate, able to convey this message in genial way and most importantly: be a good listener.

We were delighted to have Ms. Sanjana Singh, Chief Curator at *Terribly Tiny Tales*, a pioneer in the field of micro-fiction conduct their Flagship Writing Workshop in our campus, on day 3. Micro-fiction refers to the art of being able to communicate in a space of 2-3 lines what would otherwise take you paragraphs to convey. This is a growing form of literature since it caters to the demand of the busy lifestyles all of us live. It also enhances the vocabulary and demands a lot of creativity from the writer. An introduction was provided into the basic layout of a micro-tale and how to proceed writing yours. The students were then given a scenario and asked to write down their tales using the *TTT* mobile application. These tales would then be curated at *ttt* and a lucky few would win free memberships to the *TTT*. 'When our eyes first met', 'drunk texts' and an open letter to a family member garnered most responses from the audience.

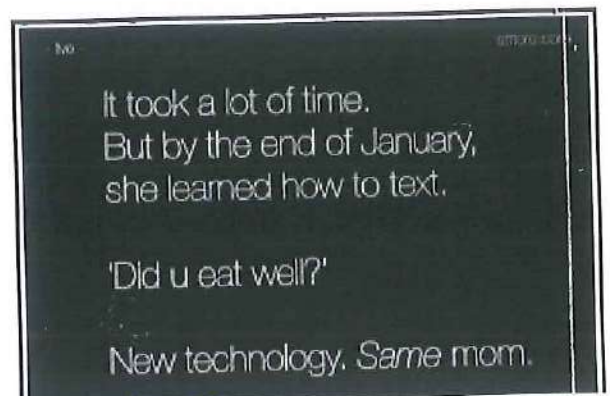

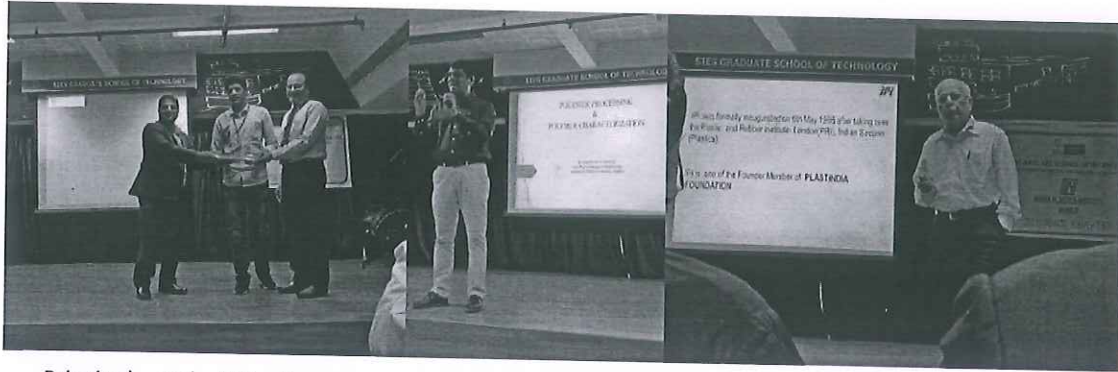

It was first Jointly organised FDP on “**Geoinformatics and Related Open Source Technology**” by **SIES Graduate School of Technology, Nerul Navi Mumbai** and **Graduate School of Engineering, Osaka City University, Japan**. It was Attended by 20 Faculties from different Institutes.

On first day of FDP, Dr. V. B. - Aggregate data on a server and extract it in useful formats

On Third Day of the Event, Mr.NatrajVaddadi and Er. H. K. Solanki elaborated QGIS (previously known as Quantum GIS) is a free and open Source cross platform desktop geographic information system (GIS) application that supports viewing, editing, and analysis of geospatial data. QGIS supports both raster and vector layers; vector data is stored as either point, line, or polygon features. Multiple formats of raster images are supported, and the software can geo-reference images

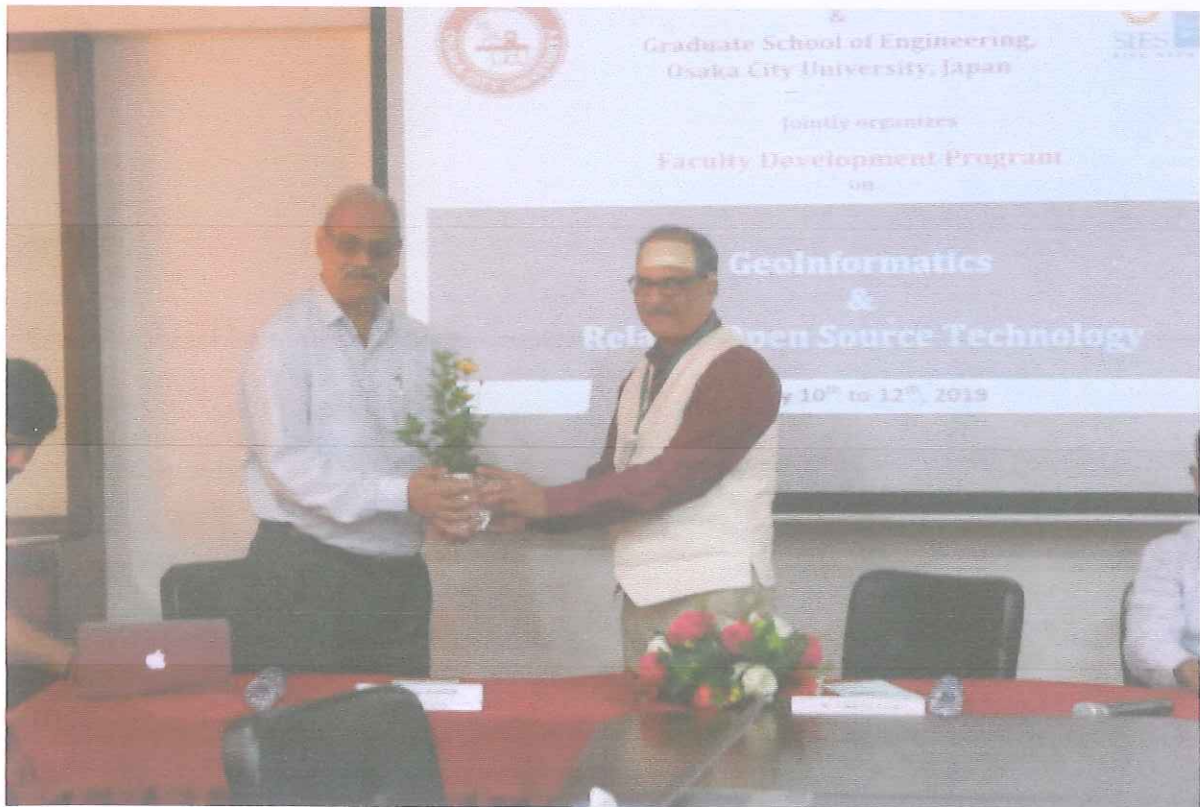




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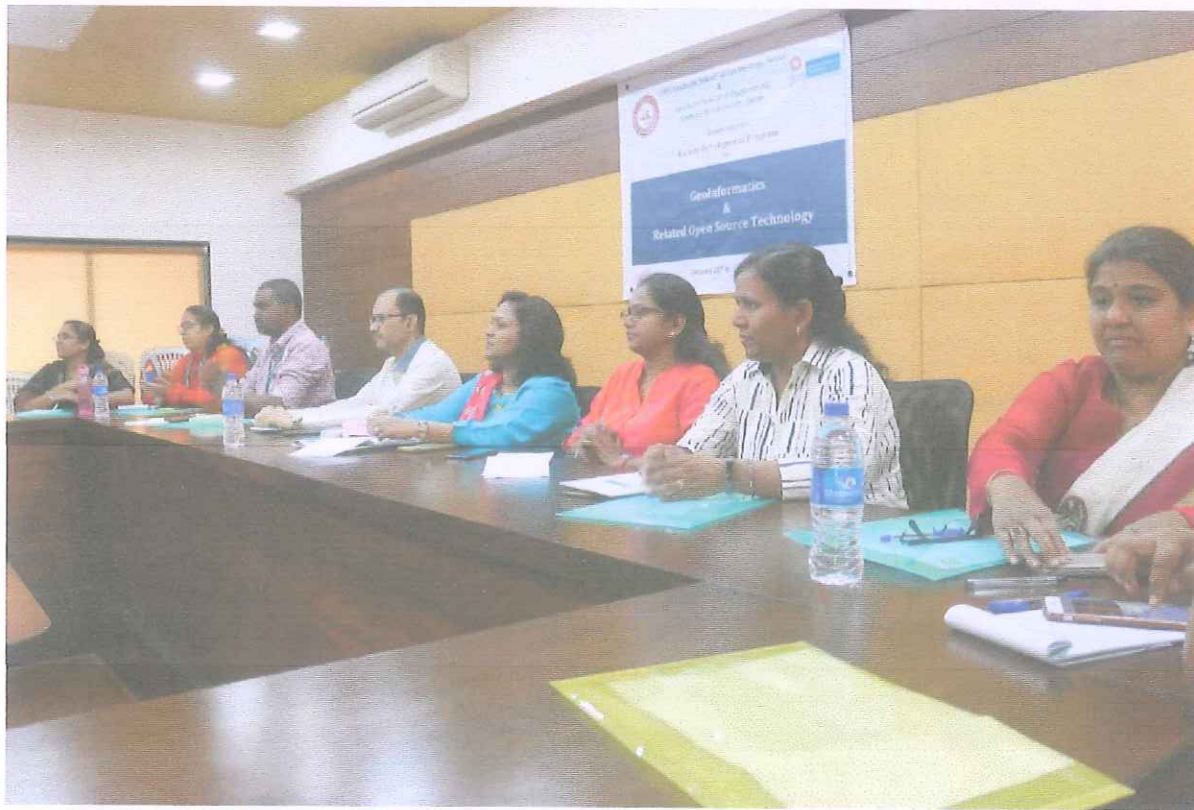

We are glad to announce that we are in the process of organising a one day workshop on the 'open source library software Koha' for the project National Virtual Library of India (NVL) that I am leading. The NVL project is an initiative of the Ministry of Culture, Government of India.

I am writing this mail to request your help in conducting this workshop. Details of this programme are given below:

Coordinator Workshop (1 day): Saturday, 29 September 2018

Main Workshop (1 day): Friday, 12 October 2018

How the main workshop will be conducted?

It will be a one day workshop, on 12 October 2018. There will be interactions through A-VIEW at the beginning. After that, all participants at your remote centre will learn Koha, using your computers, at a location in your RC. In the evening, we shall connect through A-VIEW again, carry out discussions and end the programme. There will be about 4 hours available for Koha training and 2 hours for interactions, a detailed schedule of which will be sent later to you.

The participants of the main workshop will pay Rs. 100 as a course fee to IIT Bombay, and Rs. 400 to the RC directly, from which, you will have to provide lunch and tea/snacks. The balance amount can be kept as a partial compensation for the use of your infrastructure.

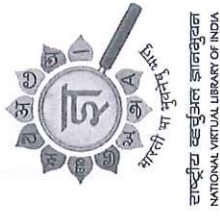
