Event Description

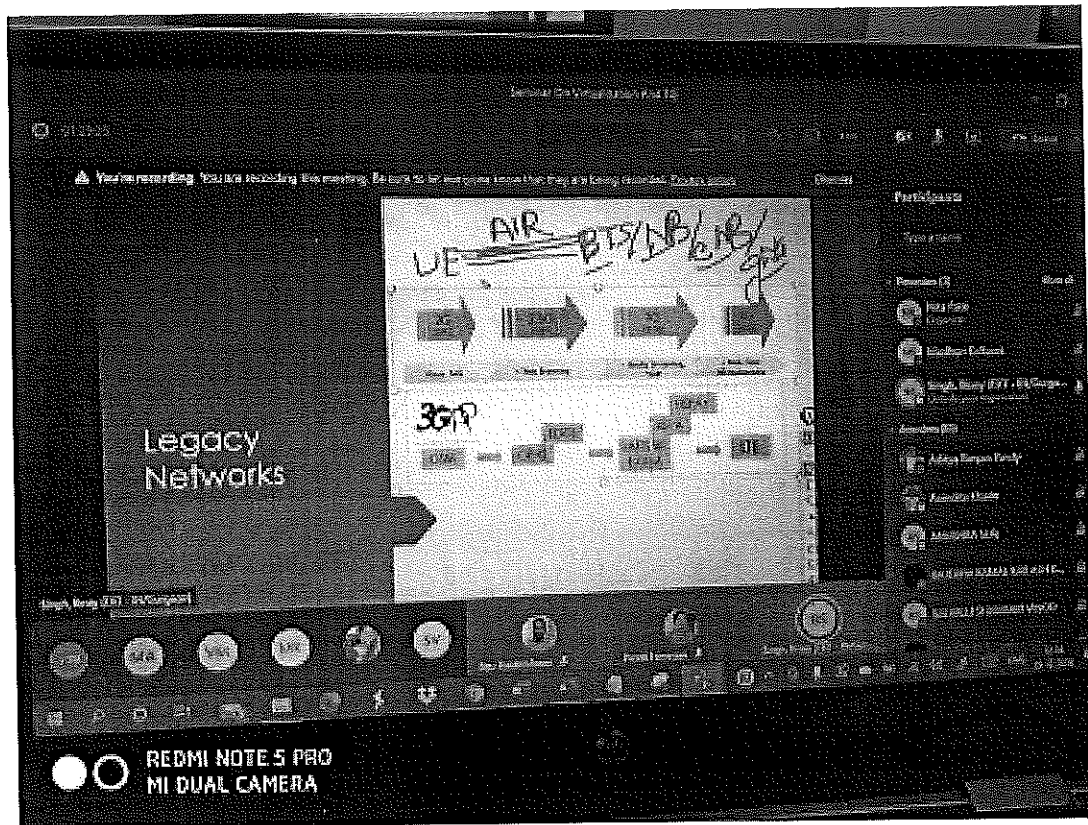
