
Event Report

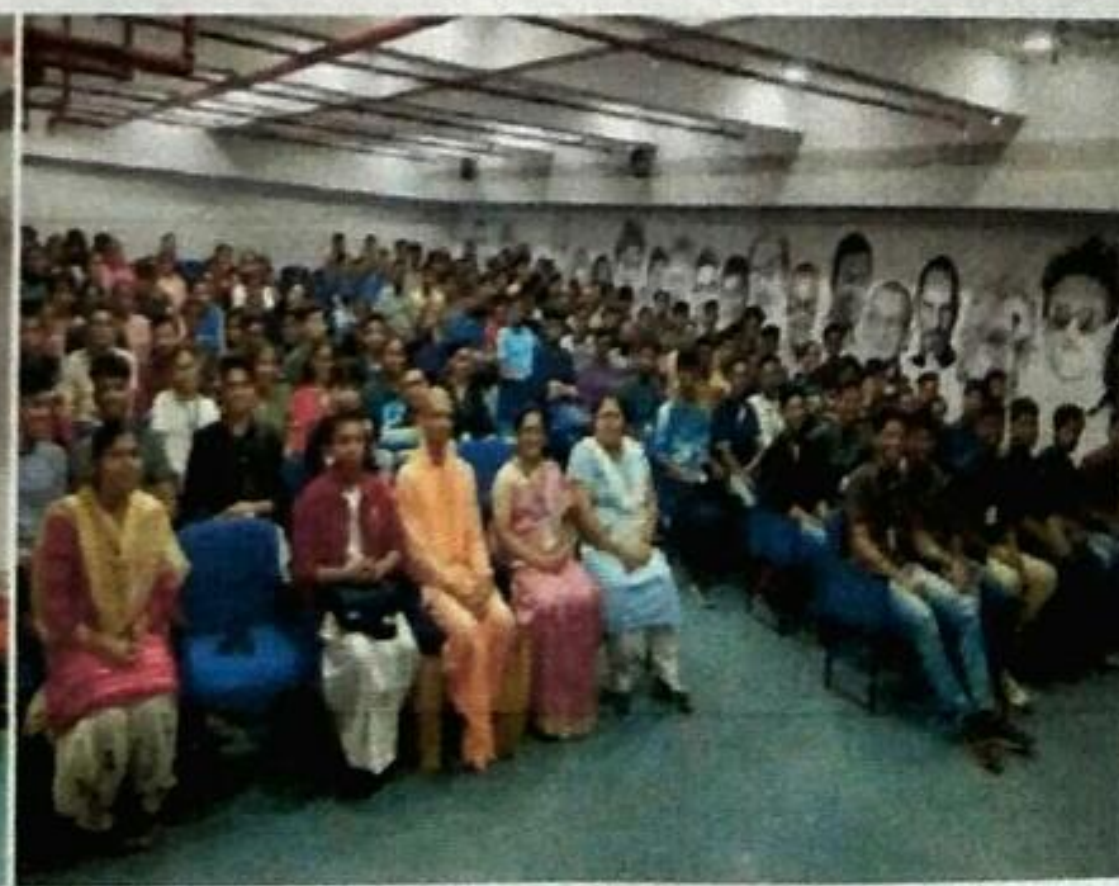

2. Department Initiatives:

Various initiatives were taken by the Department of Humanities & Applied Sciences to enhance knowledge and skills of the students, through various activities conducted throughout the year. The initiatives undertaken by the department, during AY 2019-20 are listed below:

- A seminar on **Universal Human Values** was organized by H & AS department on Mar 11, 2020 for FE students with the main aim to promote values and to nurture culture that facilitates academic atmosphere and competency development among the students. The session was conducted by Swamiji Sauri Chaitanya Das Prabhu, ISKCON volunteer on “**Positive Thinking and Conflict Resolution**”. He enlightened the students with his thought provoking ideas. Swamiji explained the power of positive thinking and various ways for conflict resolutions. The session was lively, with great enthusiastic involvement of all students.



- Poster Presentation Competition exclusively for FE "**Promethean: An Engineer's solution to Environmental Problems**" was held during 3 Jan – 31 Jan 2020, where students were exposed to contemporary environmental problems, while they came up with innovative ideas and Engineering solutions to combat the crisis. First year students were guided by the Promethean volunteers, before the event, through a series of Workshops on various aspects of presentation.



- **Five days FE induction program (7 Aug – 13 Aug, 2019)**, organised by the Department of Humanities and Applied Sciences, started with a **traditional orientation session** on the first day. Dr. P.V. Parameshwaran, Advisor, SIESGST, Dr. Atul Kemkar, I/C Principal, Dr. Manasi Karkare, Dean of First Year Engineering and the Heads of all departments addressed the students and briefed all students of the rules and regulations of

the institute. On day 2, students attended a **Universal Human Value session** on “Interpersonal relationship” by expert speaker, Ms. Vaidehi Chattrre, a corporate lawyer associated with Chinmaya trust. Activities like **resume building workshop**, LinkedIn and github sessions were organised for the students by the technical team of SIES-GST. Other activities like **Yoga, Self defence** and Physical activity session were also conducted by the experts. On day 3, students attended **Disaster Management workshop** by an expert team. Various sessions on cultural, creative, literary, media, sports, design, and robotics were organised throughout the day. On the final day, Speaker sessions (**Block Chain: Mr. Vikash Kumar, Technical games: Mr. Vivek**) by the experts and our college Alumni (Mr. Ashok) were organised to educate the students on the latest technologies. It ended with a feedback session of the students. The entire event was successful and the students enjoyed all activities thoroughly.

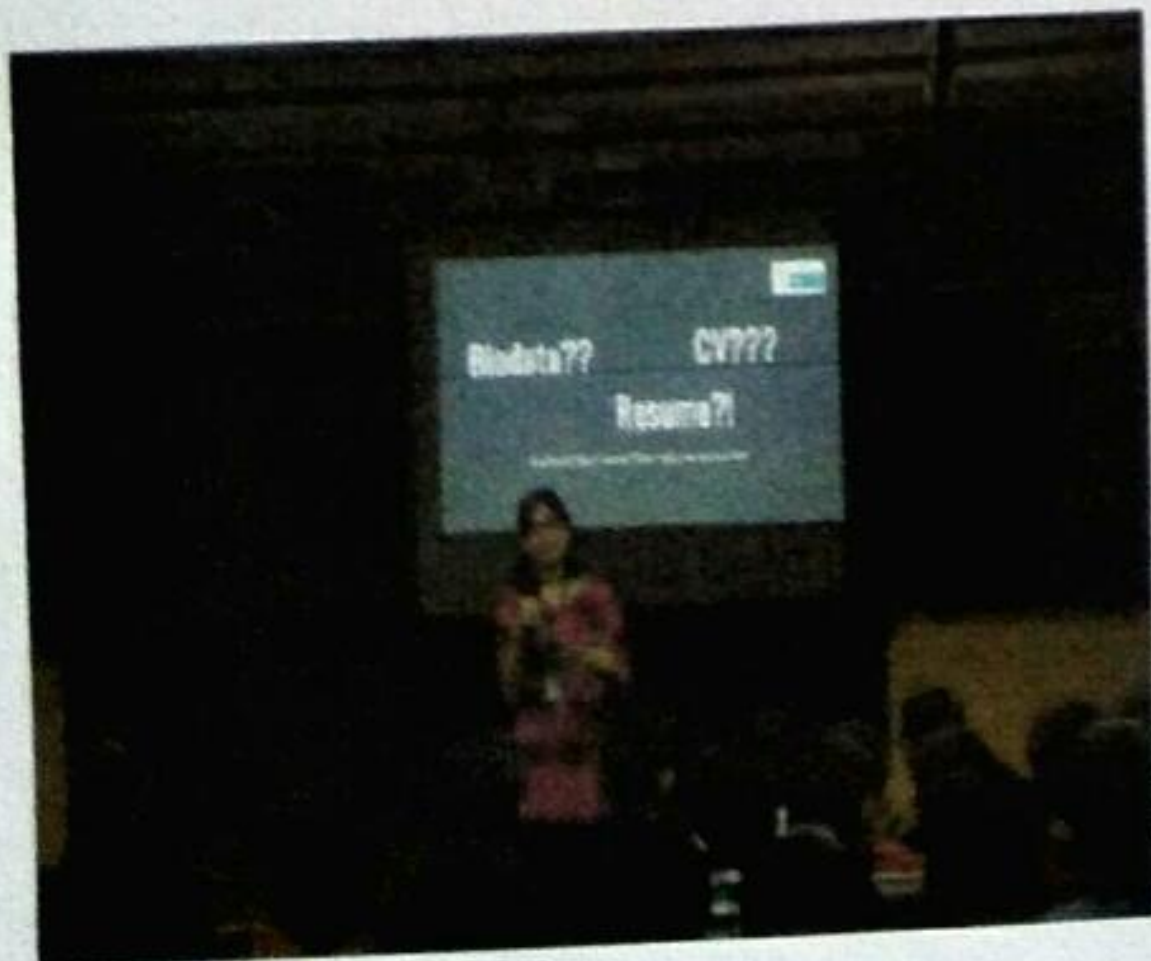
