Event Description

The fifth iteration of Model United Nations 2019 was conducted on 16th and 17th February 2019. It was a two-day international relations conference for all the college students at SIES Graduate School of Technology, Nerul. This year, there were two committees, DISEC (Disarmament and International Security) and UNHRC (United Nations Human Rights Council) highlighting on the agendas:

- 1) DISEC – (i) Restricting the use of Cyber Warfare
(ii) Terrorism: Prevention of financing and arms trade
- 2) UNHRC - (i) Reviewing the Right to Privacy
(ii) Legalization of Euthanasia

With these agendas, DISEC had 23 delegates and UNHRC had 37 delegations. DISEC committee was chaired by Mr. Puneet Pathak and UNHRC was chaired by Mr. Rangan Majumdar and co-chaired by Mr. Vignesh Narayanan. Both the committees saw an enthusiastic participation of the delegates.

The DISEC committee saw Dhaval Mehta from NMIMS School of Law as the winner of MUN'19 and Swarnim Mudaliar from Bhartiya Vidyapeeth bagged the high commendation award. Whereas in UNHRC committee, Tanmay Patil and Shubham Ghar from VG College of Arts, Science and Commerce stood as the winners of MUN'19 and Varun Sreedhar and Rushikesh Joglekar from SIES Graduate School of Technology bagged the high commendation award.

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Anveshana Report

UDGAM, in collaboration with Agastya foundation, undertook a project ANVESHANA, which was a Science & Engineering competition conducted by Agastya Int. Foundation, further culminated in a fair where the students exhibited their projects/models. This competition primarily involved undergraduate Engineering students and underprivileged school-going students where the students together followed philosophies and practiced hands-on learning, research orientation and making models based on Engineering-Science concepts. The engineering students mentored these students in the creation of models while inducing knowledge and confidence in them.

Engineering colleges participated as teams with 2 members. The teams then selected 2 students from nearby underprivileged schools (Govt. and Govt. aided schools) to mentor them to design and build models or projects around an identified social problem. The school students thus received exposure to the entire planning, designing and building process of the models and in turn will get educated in the scientific and engineering concepts behind the models in Anveshana.

Teams from various branches in SIES GST participated in the competition. Starting from December upto February, students made regular visits to the school located near the college to teach the school kids. They explained all the basic concepts pertaining to their projects to them. Four teams from our college were in the top 25 and one of them bagged the consolation prize. Overall it was a great experience for both the school kids as well as the engineering students.




It is an initiative taken by Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India which was organized by the EDC Incharge faculty

Dr.Kaustubh Chavan and Student Council incharge Prof. Sumitra Padmanabhan along with EDC SIESGST.

The Awareness camp was organized on 27th,28th September 2019 and 05th October 2019 with four speaker sessions and an industrial visit.

Day 1(27th September 2019):

The event began with an inauguration ceremony by lightning of lamp by our I/C principal Dr.Atul Khemkar,Mr. Randeep Singh Lobana (Founder Commutech.Ltd) and Dr.Kaustubh Chavan sir. The event was flagged off by the inspiring words from Dr.Kaustubh Chavan.

The First session was by Mr.Randeep Singh Lobana (Commutech.Ltd) in which he shared his experience of studying mechanical engineering from IIT Bombay and how he took up his entrepreneurial career in information technology.He shared his hardships faced and taught students how to look into entrepreneurship as a career option. He did a small group activity for the students by making them share the ideas criticizing it as a third party and showing them the reality using Google search engine.

The second Session was by Mr.Saurabh Sinha (Rein labs.Ltd).He shared his experiences as an entrepreneur and the 10 Mantras of how to be an entrepreneur as well as taught the students how to make a business model.

Day 2 (28th September 2019):

The Session one was flagged off by Ms. Smedha Sarkar (Edumaan.Ltd) by sharing her amazing experience in the teaching field and what led her to be an enabler of employment and entrepreneurship. She taught the students on how to market the product and the company with a sketch pens and chart papers.

The second session was conducted by Mr. Pranab Salian (Founder IP Hawk) and Gaurav Shetty (Co founder Ip Hawk). They covered the points such as: Introduction & Entrepreneurship Journey (Pranab Salian), Why, What and How to Start-up as a founder (Pranab Salian), Experience and challenges of working at a startup (Gaurav Shetty), Workshop part A: Building a Pitch Deck (Pranab Salian), Workshop part B: Building an MVP (Gaurav Shetty), Experiences of raising funds (Pranab Salian).

Day 3 (05th October 2019):

The Final Day of the Entrepreneurship camp was the Industrial Visit to ISDI-Indian School of Design and Innovation where Students were taught by Amit Kundal on how to think innovatively and make a product useful for the people as well as does not harm the environment. There was a session on Data Science by Anshul Gupta who taught us how today's startup giants recommend the items and services to the users.

Coronaviruses are a large family of viruses which may cause illness in animals or humans. In humans, several coronaviruses are known to cause respiratory infections ranging from the common cold to more severe diseases such as Middle East Respiratory Syndrome (MERS) and Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS). The most recently discovered coronavirus causes coronavirus disease COVID-19.

What is COVID-19?

COVID-19 is the infectious disease caused by the most recently discovered coronavirus. This new virus and disease were unknown before the outbreak began in Wuhan, China, in December 2019.

SOME WHO MYTH-BUSTERS

- Extreme climates (snow/hot and humid) do not stop the spread of coronavirus.
- The coronavirus CANNOT be transmitted through mosquito bites or through animals such as dogs/cats.
- Hand dryers and taking hot baths are NOT effective in preventing the coronavirus.
- Ultraviolet light SHOULD NOT be used for sterilization and can cause skin irritation.
- Thermal scanners CANNOT detect coronavirus.
- No existing vaccine/medicine is effective against prevention/treatment of coronavirus.
- Rinsing nose with saline/ gargling salt water does not prevent coronavirus.
- There is NO evidence that eating garlic helps in prevention of coronavirus.
- Antibiotics DO NOT work against viruses.

SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

If you have a flu or cough, please follow your symptoms as mentioned:-

Day 0 (Contact with virus):

• Fatigue

Day 3:

• Mild fever with cough
• Itchy throat

Day 4:

• Mild headache

Day 5:

• Diarrhea or cramps
• Headache
• Normal fever (may increase)

Day 6/7:

• Increased body pain
• Headache may reduce
• Diarrhea may increase
• Loss of appetite


Day 8/9: If from day 8, your condition starts to worsen, instead of getting better, only then get yourself tested.





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4) Video on Topic: Making a mask at home



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6) Video on Topic: Relaxations after 20th April
