Event Description

IEEE SIES GST conducted a seminar on "Communication and its Implications", on Saturday, 16th September, 2019 between 3:30 am to 5:00 pm at SIES Graduate School of Technology, Nerul.

The speakers for the session were Mr. Krishna Mohan, the Director of 'Craftin Images', Mr. Sameer Narkar, Founder, Director and Chief Software Architect of 'Konnect Insights', and Mr. Suyash Gogate, Marketing Head of 'Caribbean Cruise'.

The session started with the welcoming of the guest speakers. Mr. Krishna Mohan then talked about the importance of communication and how communication skills are a must in every aspect of day to day life. He talked about the different ways of communicating with people like verbal, non-verbal, etc. and the most important part, i.e. two-way communication. He taught the students about the three main aspects of communication; Speaking, Listening and Understanding.

Mr. Sameer Narkar enlightened the students about the importance of communication on an industrial level. He shared the experiences of his student life and how communication skills helped him achieve his goals. He then interacted with the students and answered all their technical queries.

Mr. Suyash Gogate talked about the difficulties faced due to the lack of communication skills. He shared his experience about how he was shy when it came to speaking or communicating and how he managed to tackle such difficulties. He also gave some ideas to overcome stage fright, shyness, etc. to become a better communicator.

All the 15 teams presented their idea after the end of 24 hrs in front of our Judges, Mr. Siddharth Kumar and Mr. Santosh Chapaneri.







The fifth edition of SIESGST MUN was conducted on 15th and 16th of February 2019. It consisted of two committees - the UNGA DISEC and the UNHRC. The first Committee, the UNGA DISEC or United Nations General Assembly Disarmament and International Security Council, had two agendas: - Restricting the use of Cyber Warfare and Terrorism: Prevention of Financing and Arms Trade. The problems were rated in ascending order of difficulty with the A being the simplest and F being the toughest.


The competition was healthy but fierce as coders fought with each other and the problems to come out at the top.

This competition gave real world exposure to all the participants who attended the competition.








Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (Waste Management) Filtration of Compost generated in SIES Campus on 09/09/17


The NSS volunteers of SIES GST are responsible for the inauguration and the maintenance of the Compost pit in the college. From time to time the compost needs to be processed to be sold in the markets. The volunteers thus gathered on the 9th of September 2017 to do the same. Unprocessed compost was brought in sacks and spread out on the floor. The volunteers were divided into groups and were told to crush the mixture to obtain a much finer product. A 'filtered' version of the compost was also prepared which included passing the compost through a filter. This reduced the coarse particles into a much finer powdered mixture and can be sold at a slightly higher price. The processed compost was packed in newspaper bags and will used for Campus beautification/ gardening or sold at nominal price to interested buyers who wish to increase the fertility of the soil.
